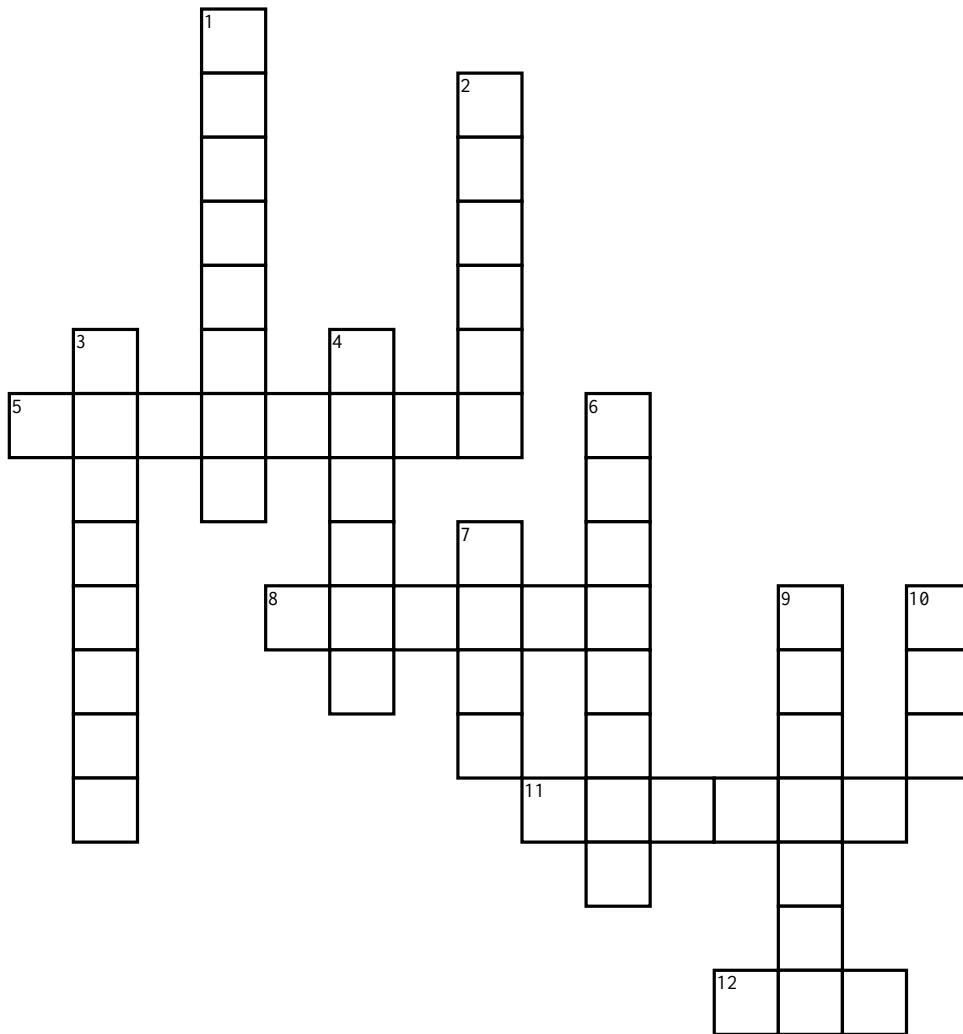

3. a programmable electronic device designed to accept data, perform prescribed mathematical and logical operations at high speed, and display the results of these operations.

4. a networking device that forwards data packets between computer networks.
