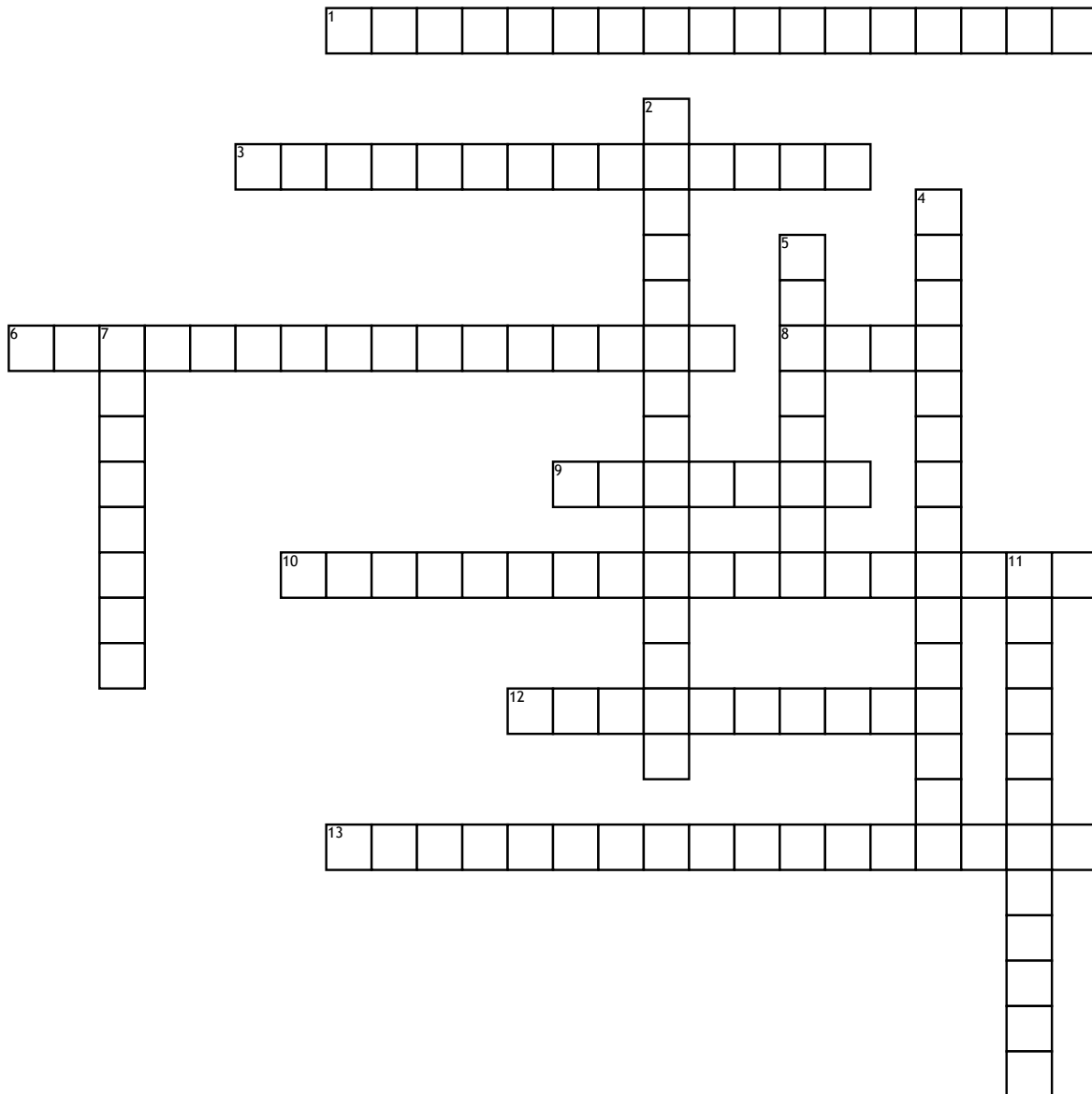


The workforce of The future
