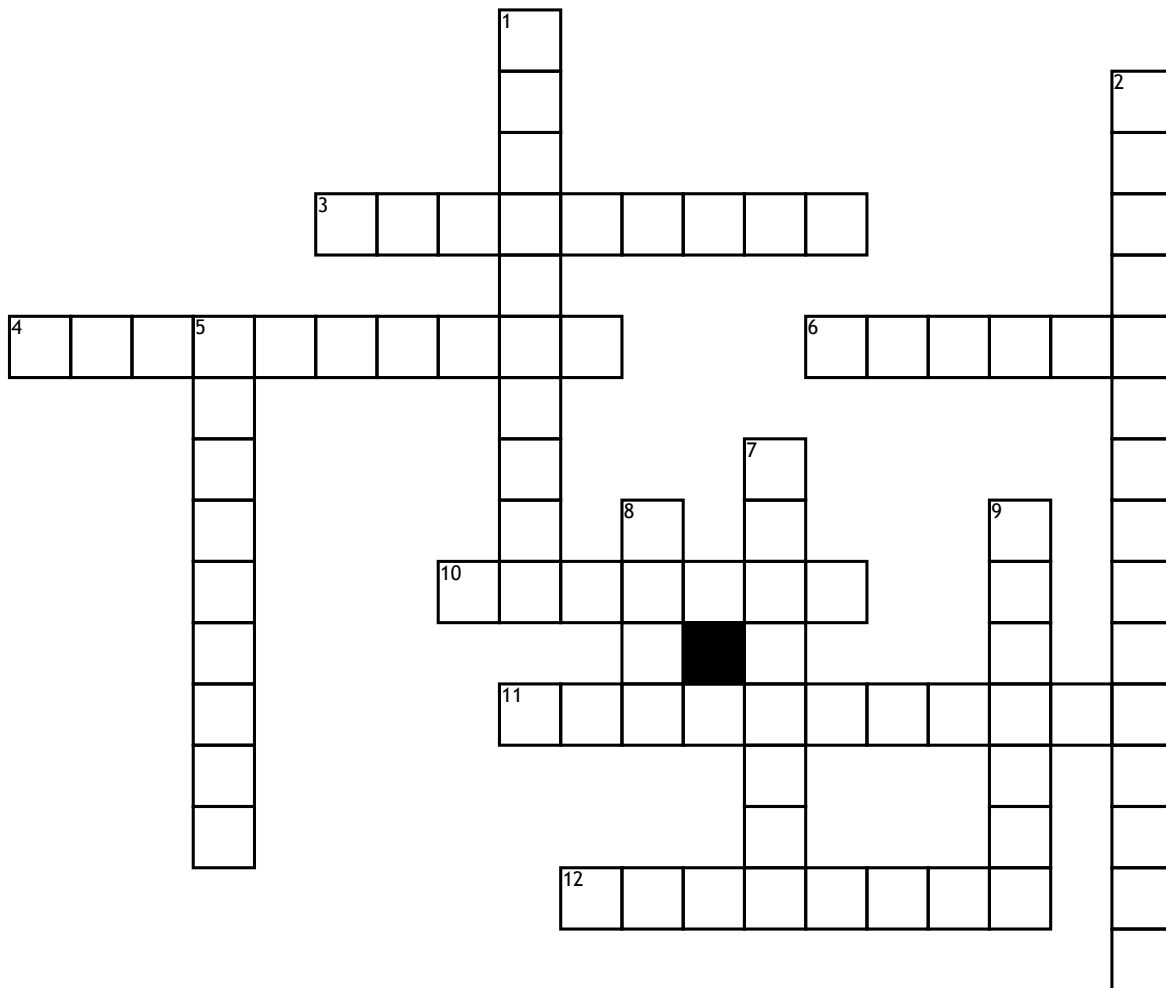

7. Calvary is the name of the place, outside of Jerusalem, where Jesus was crucified. The name Calvary means "The Skull".

8. The Gospel of John refers a number of times to a town called Cana of Galilee.
