

- **2.** Cuts effortlessly through hard materials- such as ceramic or porcelain tile, concrete, and bricks
- 7. Marks lines out to make sure that the first line of tiles is straight
- **9.** Cuts through materials
- **10.** Dense, absorbent sponges that remove excess grout from the surface of the tiles with ease
- **12.** Makes sure that your work is at level!

- **13.** Nibbles the tiles to create shaped edges that the tile cutter can't handle
- **14.** invaluable plastic crosses that ensure the space between each tile is uniform & stop the tile from slipping

Down

- 1. Can be used for many things but also sponging clean the grout from the tiles
- **3.** Evenly spread of mortar on the wall or tile

- **4.** A flat trowel used to spread the grout into the gaps between the tiles
- **5.** Gently nudges the tile into place and ensure it bonds properly
- **6.** Another tool to evenly spread of mortar on the wall or tile
- **8.** Long-stemmed implements with a motor that whisks motar
- 11. Drives objects (like nails)
