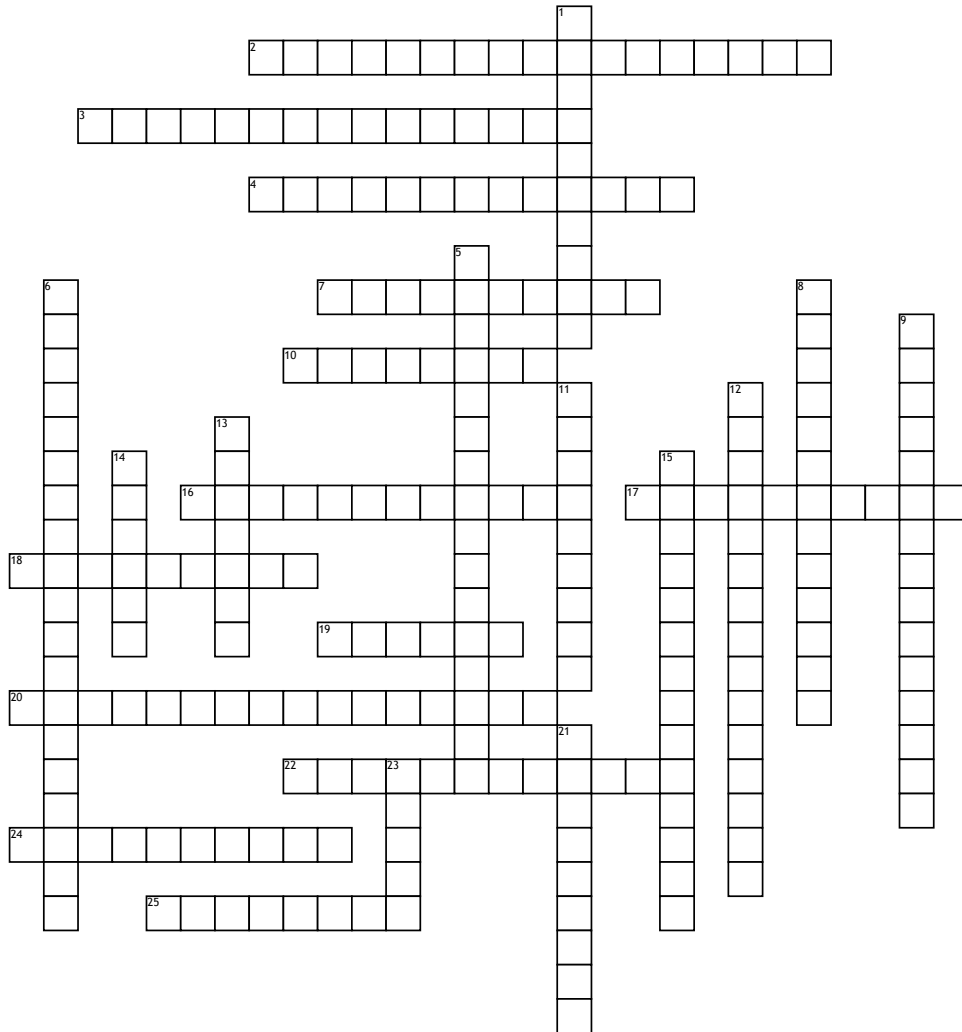

- 10. King right after James I who brought back Roman Catholicism
- 16. Leader of the Protestant Reformation
- 17. Author of Institutes of Christian Religion
- 18. First Colony in North America
- 19. Family that no longer controls/rules England in 1603
- 20. First governing document for Plymouth Colony

- 22. Person that led establishing the Fundamental Orders of Connecticut 1639
- 24. Codified the Laws of England in 890
- 25. Also known as “a friend to Reformation thinking”

- 1. Written in order to make peace between the unpopular King and a group of rebel barons (promised the protection of church rights, protection for the barons from illegal imprisonment, access to swift justice, and limitations on feudal payments to the Crown)
- 5. Series of trials in Massachusetts that led to the prosecution of people falsely accused of witchcraft
- 6. Major Revivalism that occurred across America

- 8. Author of Institutes of the Laws of England
- 9. English constitutional document setting out specific individual protections against the state
- 11. Established the Church of England
- 12. Wrote/believed in the tract called Vindiciae Contra Tyrannos
- 13. The first attempted permanent settlement in North America
- 14. First Stuart King
- 15. Pope while there were reforms to free the Roman Catholic Church from the control of European political rulers in 1075
- 21. Author of A Short Treatise of Politick Power
- 23. Executed many Protestants (nicknamed “Bloody Mary”)
