

- **4.** "outside" surface posterior teeth, which is toward the cheek
- **5.** four sections each containing eight teeth
- 7. developmental groove resulting from an imperfect union where the lobes come together
- **9.** three bulges on the incisal edge of a newly erupted central incisors

- **10.** pulverizing or chewing surface
- **13.** upper arch in the dentition
- **14.** surface of the tooth that is towards the tongue
- **15.** is the triangular space in the gingival direction when two adjacent teeth are in contact

- 1. the primary "baby" teeth
- 2. used to chew food

- **3.** surface away from the midline
- **6.** often called the bicuspid
- **8.** space between two teeth, normally in reference to the maxillary centrals
- 11. convex area on the lingual surface of the anterior teeth near the gingiva
- **12.** at or near the end of the root
