

## **Across**

- **5.** place where the grooves come together or the fissures
- **8.** surface closest to the midline
- **9.** surface away from midline
- 10. used to chew food
- **11.** upper arch in the dentition

- **12.** Three bulges on the incisal edge of the newly erupted central incisors
- **13.** pulverizing or chewing surface
- **15.** developmental groove resulting from an imperfect union where the lobes come together

## Down

- 1. often called the bicuspid
- **2.** lower arch in the dentition

- **3.** convex area on the lingual surface of the anterior teeth near the gingiva
- **4.** at or near the end of the root
- **6.** space between the teeth normally in reference to the central incisors
- 7. is the triangular space in the gingival direction when two adjacent teeth are in contact
- **14.** separate parts that come together to form a tooth
