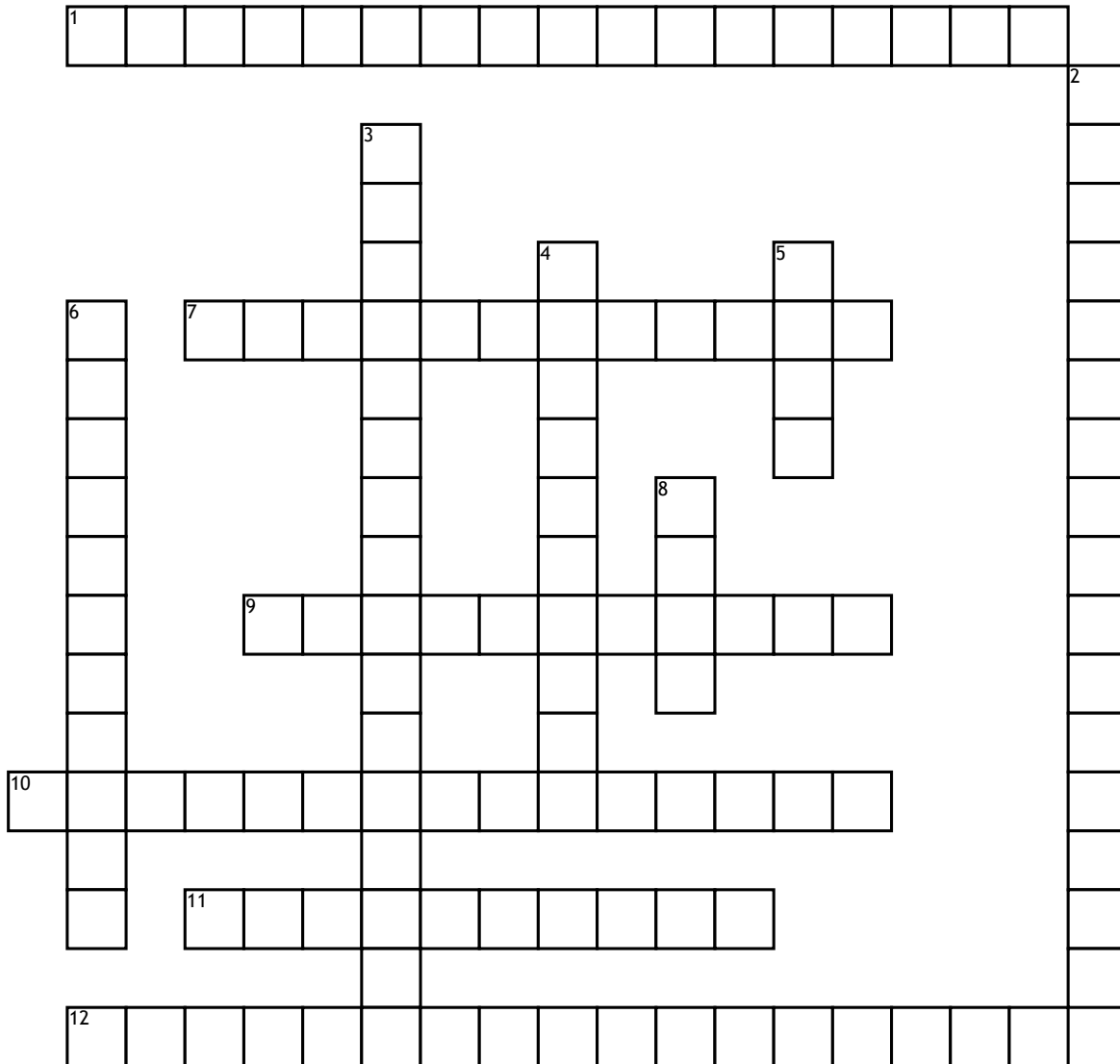

11. A phenomenon in which speed causes a bullet to generate a pressure wave, which causes damage distant from the bullet's path.

2. The _____ score is an evaluation tool used to determine LOC, which evaluates and assigns point values for eye opening, verbal response, and motor function. (3 words)

3. Awareness that unseen life-threatening injuries may exist when determining the mechanics of injury.

4. Any object propelled by force, such as a bullet or weapon.

5. The product of force times distance.

6. A score that relates to the likelihood of patient survival with the exception of severe head injury. It calculates a number from 1 to 16, with 16 being the best score. It takes into account the GCS RR, work of breathing, systolic BP and capillary refill. (2 words)
