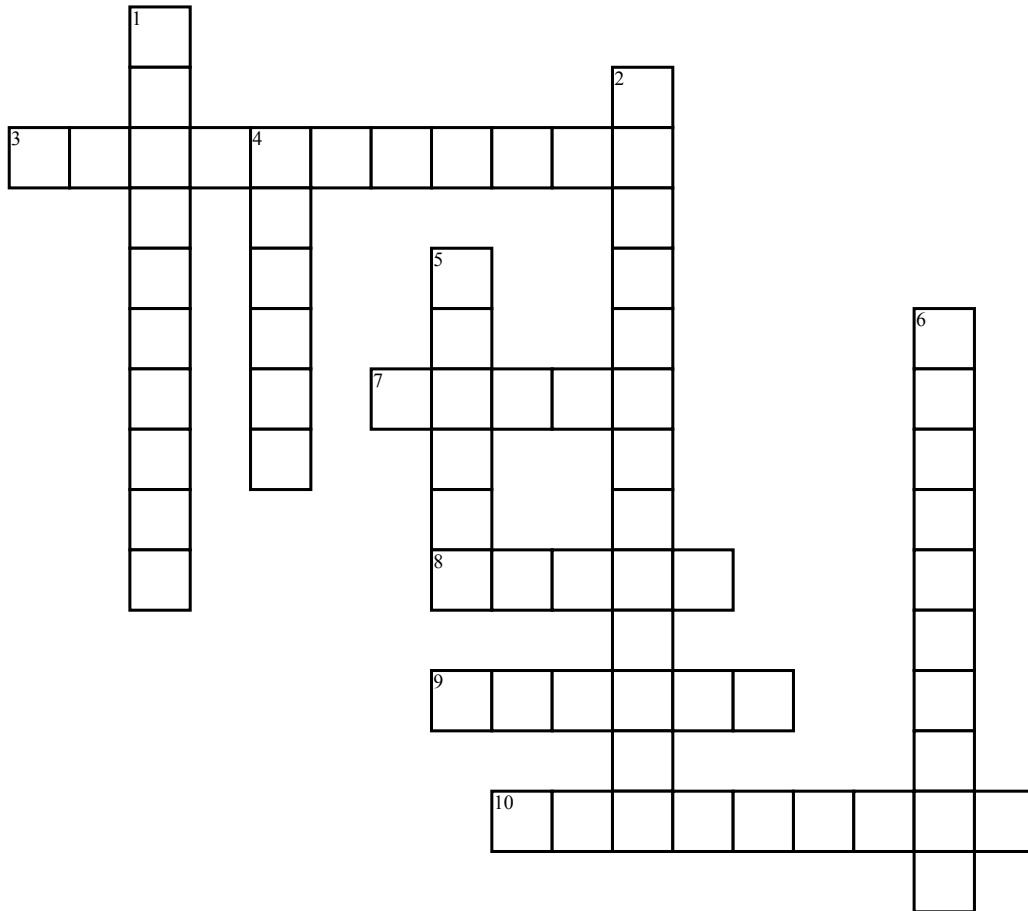


Transformation of Agriculture
