
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Transition Meds

- **1.** Anesthetic commonly used during surgery
- **4.** Monitor your patient for a chronic, dry cough
- **11.** Commonly used to increase appetite
- **12.** Monitor for signs of increased bleeding
- **13.** Used to decrease ammonia in hepatic encephalopathy

- **14.** May be used to treat familial mediterranean fever
- **15.** Treatment for high cholesterol
- **16.** Give this drug first thing, without other medications

- **2.** First line therapy for type 2 diabetes
- **3.** Never give more than 15 minutes before a meal
- **5.** Never give more than 4 grams of this drug in 24 hours

- **6.** Therapy for pulmonary fibrosis
- 7. Do not give if apical heart rate is less than 50 bpm
- **8.** Used to transition away from chronic narcotic use
- **9.** Used to decrease symptoms of restless leg syndrome
- **10.** Blocks nerve impulses to relax muscles
