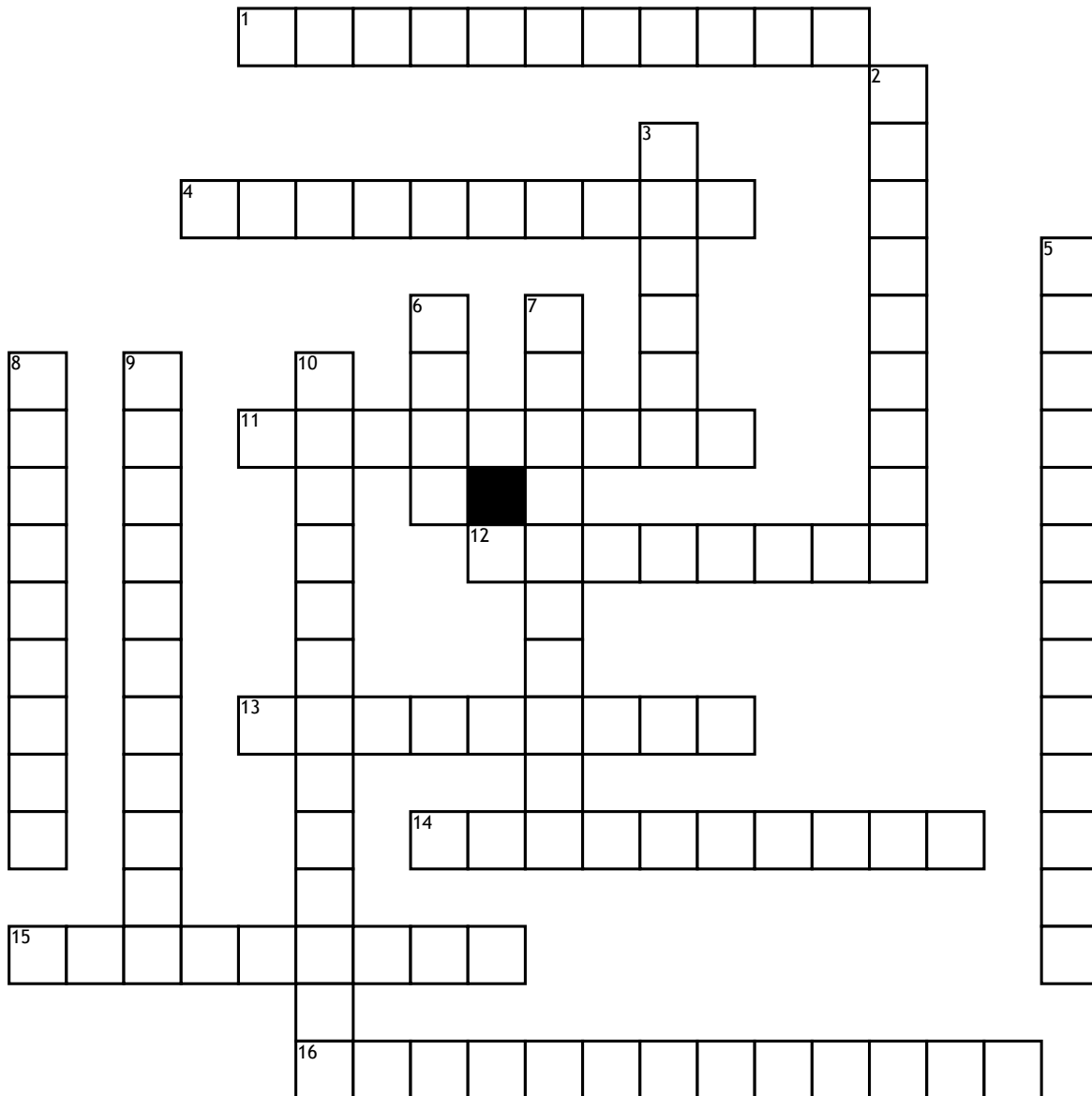

14. May be used to treat familial mediterranean fever

15. Treatment for high cholesterol

16. Give this drug first thing, without other medications

2. First line therapy for type 2 diabetes

3. Never give more than 15 minutes before a meal

5. Never give more than 4 grams of this drug in 24 hours

6. Therapy for pulmonary fibrosis

7. Do not give if apical heart rate is less than 50 bpm

8. Used to transition away from chronic narcotic use

9. Used to decrease symptoms of restless leg syndrome

10. Blocks nerve impulses to relax muscles
