


Traveling Through Space

- a real or imaginary line through the center of an object, around which the object turns.
- the blocking from view of the sun, a moon, or a planet by another body.
- one of the four parts of the year; spring, summer, fall, and winter.

- the star in the middle of our solar system.
- region beyond the atmosphere of the earth.
