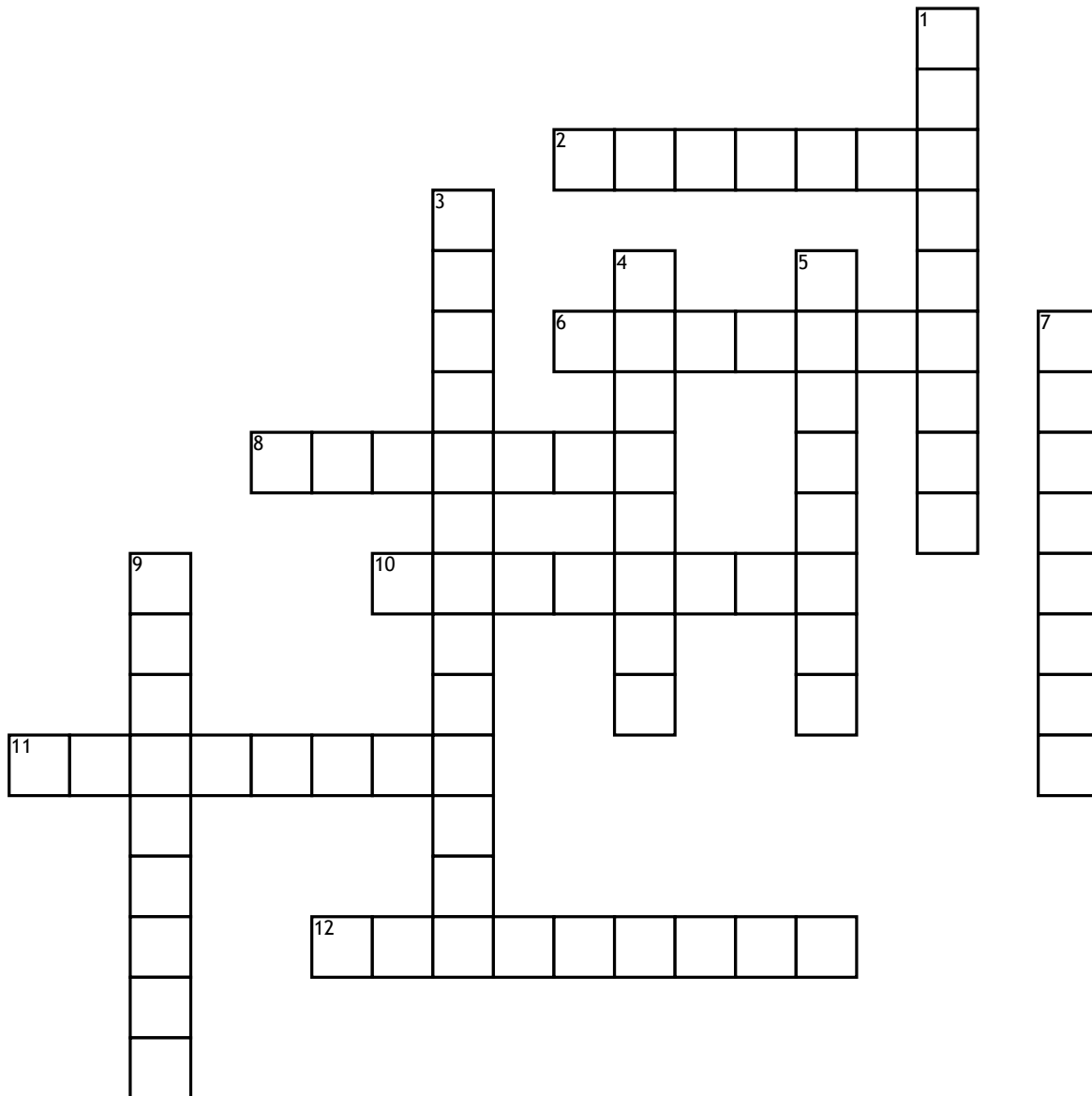


Treasure Island Crossword Puzzle

 6. a small round boat made of wickerwork covered with a watertight material, propelled with a paddle.
 8. a light, fast, narrow boat adapted for rowing or sailing.

 11. an extension of a ship's sides above the level of the deck.

12. is the back or aft-most part of a ship or boat, technically defined as the area built up over the sternpost, extending upwards from the counter rail to the taffrail.

1. a person, especially a soldier or sailor, who rebels or refuses to obey the orders of a person in authority.
 3. is the right-hand side, facing forward.

4. is the left-hand side of or direction from a vessel, facing forward. Starboard is the right-hand side, facing forward.

5. a sailing ship with two or more masts, typically with the foremast smaller than the mainmast, and having gaff-rigged lower masts.

7. a sailing warship of a size and armament just below that of a ship of the line.
