


# Two Scavengers Poetry Technique Crossword

12. This is another example of ALLITERATION to describe the young couple in the Mercedes (2 words).

13. This word should mean 'equality' but the poem clearly shows that not everybody is equal.

14. These two words show that the older garbage man has put in many years of back-breaking work (2 words).

1. This word is repeated and describes the couple in the Mercedes as being stylish.

3. An example of ALLITERATION used to describe how the young woman's hair has been styled to look like she hasn't made any effort (2 words).

4. This METAPHOR describes the men as if they are vultures feeding off other people's rubbish (one word).

6. The rich young architect and the poorer young garbage man both wear these (one word).
