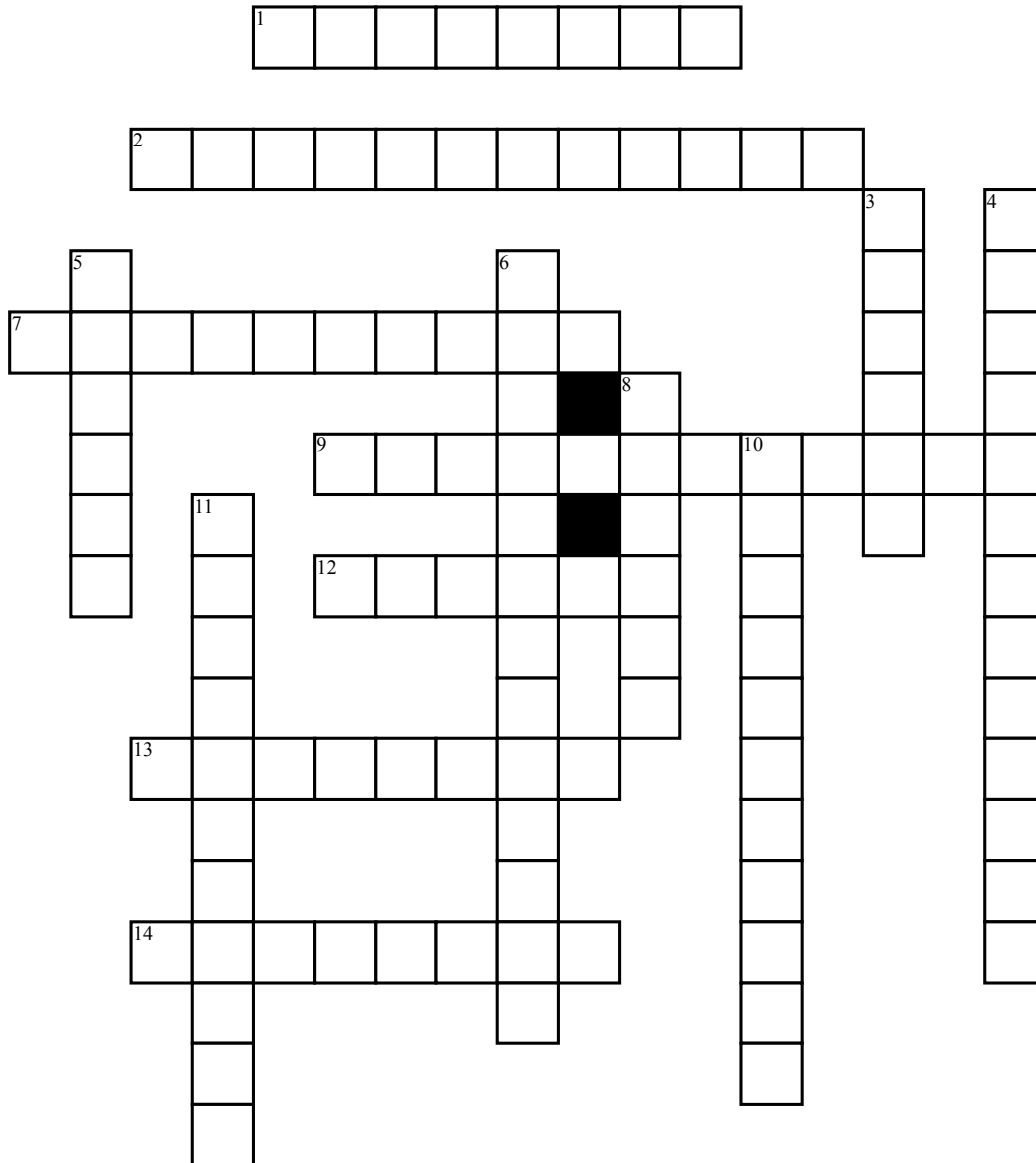


# Types of Psychologists

- 1. They work with criminal justice agencies to apply psychological expertise to activities
- 2. More user friendly, man made technical systems such as keyboards
- 7. They use interviews and test to define their clients problems
- 9. Specialize in basic processes such as the nervous system, sensation and perception, learning and memory, thought motivation, and emotion
- 12. Employed by some school systems, they identify and assist students who have problems that interfere with learning

13. Study the behaviors of shoppers in an effort to predict and influence their behavior

- 5. Primary concerned with the nature and cause of individuals thoughts, feelings, and behavior in social situations.

6. Study the way that people and the environment– the natural environment and the human-made environment– influence one another

8. Examine how behavior and mental process are related to physical health

10. Attempt to facilitate learning, but do it through course planning and instructional methods for school systems

11. Focus on goals such as identifying and measuring human traits; determining influences on human thought processes, feelings, and behaviors; and explaining psychological disorders
