

<u>Across</u>

2. presence of sugar in the urine

3. increased incidence of voiding

4. 24 hour output is less than 50mL, synonyms are complete kidney shutdown or renal failure
6. painful or difficult urination
8. strong desire to void

10. awakening at night to urinate

11. Scanty or greatly diminished amount of urine voided in a given time

12. protein in the urine; indicative of kidney disease <u>**Down**</u>

1. involuntary loss of urine

5. pus in the urine; urine appears cloudy (greater than 4WBC's per high-power field) occurs in all patients with UTI's
7. stoppage of urine production; normally the adult kidneys produce urine continuously at the rate of 60-120mL/h
9. excessive output of urine (diuresis)
