

- **4.** Pronouncement adopted by the second Continental Congress in Philadelphia on July 4th 1776
- **8.** A small but pivotal battle during the American Revolutionary War, December 26th 1776
- **9.** Deadly riot on King street in Boston in 1770
- **10.** Law passed by British Parliament in 1764 raising duties on foreign refined sugar imported by the colonies
- **11.** Punitive laws passed by the British Parliament in 1774 after the Boston Tea Party
- **12.** Functioned as the third of eight winter encampments for the Continental Army
- **13.** Pitted Colonies of British America against New France

- 1. Battle giving decisive victory to the Americans over British in the American Revolutionary War, September-October 1777
- **2.** Dumped 342 chests of tea, imported by the British East India Company into the harbor
- **3.** First Military engagements of the American Revolutionary War
- **5.** Series of four British acts of Parliament passed during 1767 and 1768
- **6.** A tax on the legal recognition of documents
- **7.** One of the eight original shires formed in colonial Virginia in 1682
