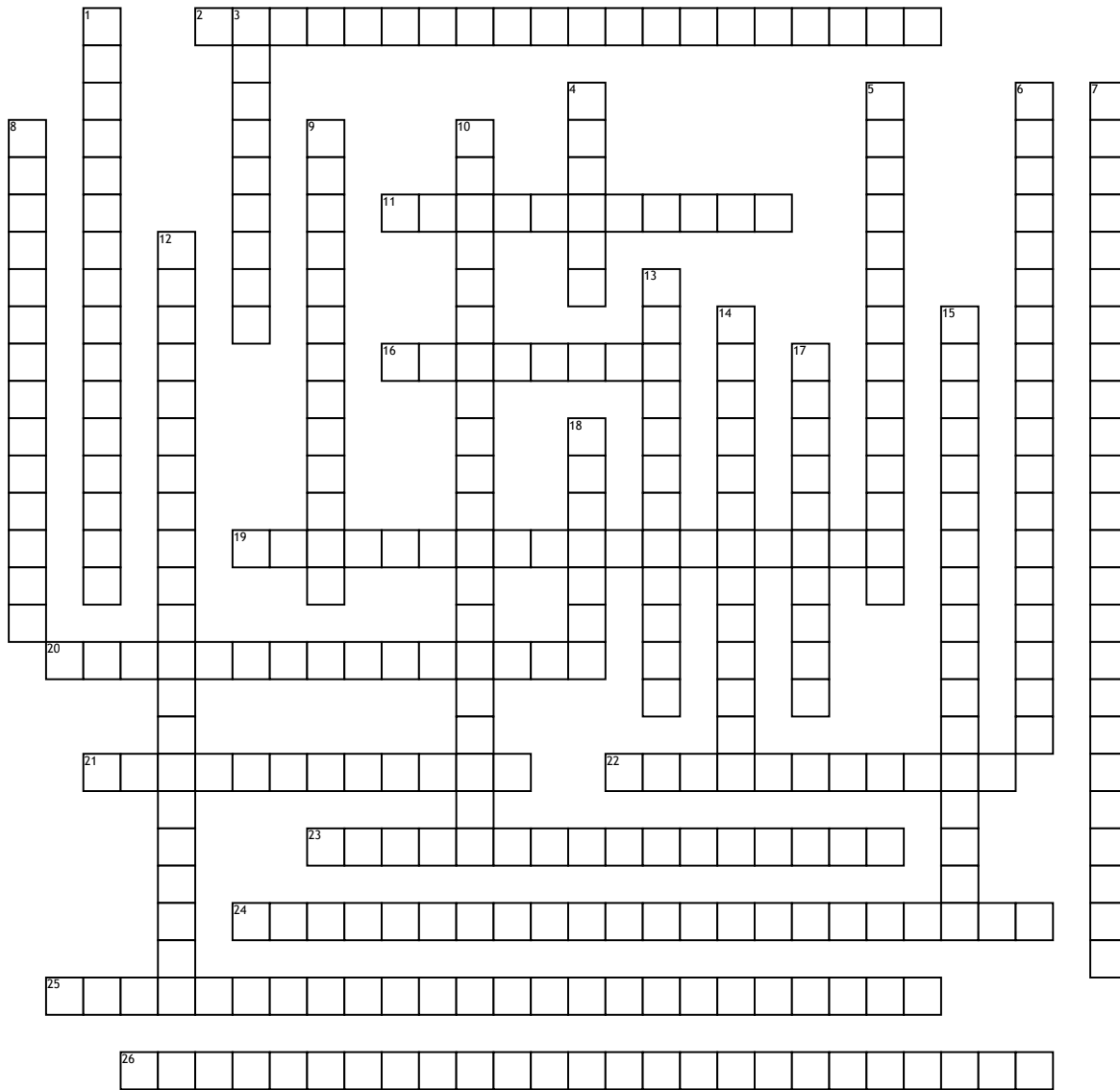

2. The first major battle of the Civil War, resulting in a Confederate victory; showed that the Civil War would not be won easily.
11. A group of northern Democrats who opposed abolition and sympathized with the South during the Civil War
16. A type of war in which an army destroys its opponents ability to fight by targeting civilian and economic as well as military resources
19. A Union Civil War victory that turned the tide against the Confederates at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania
20. A series of Civil War battles in which Confederate army successes forced the Union army to retreat from Richmond, Virginia, the Confederate capital
21. The Constitutional protection against unlawful imprisonment
22. Escaped slaves who joined the Union army during the Civil War
23. The Union army's six-week blockade of Vicksburg that led the city to surrender during the Civil War
24. Confederate general who earned the nickname "Stonewall" after holding his position during the First Battle of Bull Run

25. An order issued by President Abraham Lincoln freeing the slaves in areas rebelling against the Union
26. African American Civil War regiment that attacked Fort Wagner in South Carolina

1. A Union victory in the Civil War that marked the bloodiest single-day battle in U.S. military history
3. A warship that is heavily armored with iron
4. Union general after Bull Run who assembled a force of soldiers called the Army of Potomac
5. A failed Confederate attack during the Civil War led by General George Pickett at the Battle of Gettysburg
6. A series of battles between Union and Confederate forces in northern and central Virginia that delayed the Union capture of Richmond
7. A political party formed in 1860 by a group of northerners and southerners who supported the Union, its laws, and the Constitution
8. A Civil War battle in Tennessee in which the Union army gained greater control over the Mississippi River Valley

9. Union general who developed a two-part strategy to destroy the South's economy with a naval blockade and gain control of the Mississippi River

10. Virginia town where General Robert E. Lee was forced to surrender, thus ending the Civil War

12. A Civil War battle in which the Confederate army forced most of the Union army out of Virginia

13. Delaware, Kentucky, Maryland, and Missouri; slave states that lay between the North and South and did not join the Confederacy during the Civil War.

14. Union general during the Civil War and 18th president of the U.S.

15. A speech given by Abraham Lincoln in which he praised the bravery of the Union soldiers and renewed his commitment to winning the Civil War

17. A federal outpost in Charleston, South Carolina, that was attacked by the Confederates in April 1861, sparking the Civil War

18. Confederate general who was known for taking risks, being unpredictable, and superior military experience
