

- 10. Virginia town where General Robert E. Lee was forced to surrender, thus ending the Civil War
- **12.** A Civil War battle in which the Confederate army forced most of the union army out of Virginia
- 13. Delaware, Kentucky, Maryland, and Missouri; slave states that lay between the North and South and did not join the Confederacy during the Civil War.
- 14. Union general during the Civil war and 18th president of the U.S
- **15.** A speech given by Abraham Lincoln in which he praised the bravery of the Union soldiers and renewed his commitment to winning the Civil War
- 17. A federal outpost in Charleston, South Carolina, that was attacked by the Confederates in April 1861, sparking the Civil War
- **18.** Confederate general who as known for taking risks, being unpredictable, and superior military experience
