

- 1. African American Civil War regiment that attacked Fort Wagner in South Carolina
- 3. A Union Civil War victory that turned the tide against the Confederates at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania
- 7. A federal outpost in Charleston, South Carolina, that was attacked by the Confederates in April 1861, sparking the Civil War
- 8. Escaped slaves who joined the Union army during the Civil War
- 11. An order issued by President Abraham Lincoln freeing the slaves in areas rebelling against the Union
- 13. A union victory in Civil War that marked the bloodiest single-day battle in U.S. military history

- **14.** The Union army's six-week blockade of Vicksburg that led the city to surrender during the Civil War 15. A warship that is heavily armored

- 16. A Civil War Battle in which the Confederate army forced most of the Union army out of Virginia

- 2. A political party formed in 1860 by group of northerners and southerners who supported the Union, it's laws, and the constitution
- 4. Delaware, Kentucky, Maryland, and Missouri; slave states that lay between the North and the South and did not join the Confederacy during the Civil War

- 5. The first major battle of Civil War, resulting in a Confederate victory; showed that the Civil War would not be won easily
- 6. A series of Civil War battles in which Confederate army successes forced the Union army to retreat from Richmond, Virginia, the Confederate capital
- 9. The constitution protection against unlawful imprisonment
- 10. A Civil War Battle in Tennessee in which the Union Army gained greater control over the Mississippi River Valley
- 12. A group of northern Democrats who opposed abolition and sympathized with the South during the Civil War
