

- **4.** The first major battle in which Confederate victory; showed that the Civil War would not be won easily
- **6.** A Union victory in the Civil War that marked the bloodiest single-day battle in U.S. military history
- 12. A type of war in which an army destroys its opponent's ability to fight by targeting civilian and economic as well as milotary resources
- 17. Confederate general who was known for taking risks, being unpredictable, and superior military experience
- **18.** A series of Civil War battles in which Confedrate army successes forced the Union army to retreat from Richmond, Virginia, the Confederate capital
- 19. A federal outpost in Charleston, South Carolina that was attacked by the Confederates in April 1861, sparking the Civil War

- **20.** The constitional protection against unlawful imprisonment
- **21.** A speech given by Abraham Lincoln in which he praised the bravery of the Union soldiers and renewed his commitment to winning the Civil War
- **22.** Union general after Bull Run who assembled a force of soldiers called the Army of Potomac
- **23.** African American Civil War regiment that attacked Fort Wagner in South Carolina
- **24.** A Civil War battle in which the Confederate army forced most of the Union army out of Virginia
- **2.** Virginia town where General Robert E.Lee was forceed to surrender, thus ending the Civil War
- 3. A civil War battle in Tennesse in which the Union army gained greater control over the Mississippi River Valley
- **5.** A political party formed in 1860 by a group of northerners and southners who supported the Union, its laws, and the Constitution
- 7. A warship that is heavily armored with iron

- **8.** Confedrate general who earned the nickname "Stonewall" after holding his position during the First Battle of Bull Run
- **9.** An order issued by President Abraham Lincoln freeing the slaves in areas rebelling against the Union
- **10.** A Union War victory that turned the tide against the Confederates at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania
- **11.** Union general during the Civial war and 18th President of the United States
- 13. Escaped slaves who joined the Union army during the Civil War
- 14. A failed Confederate attack during the Civil War led by General George Pickett at the Battle of Gettsburg
- 15. Delaware, Kentucky, Maryland, and Missouri; slave states that lay between the North and the South and did not that Confedracy during the Civil War
