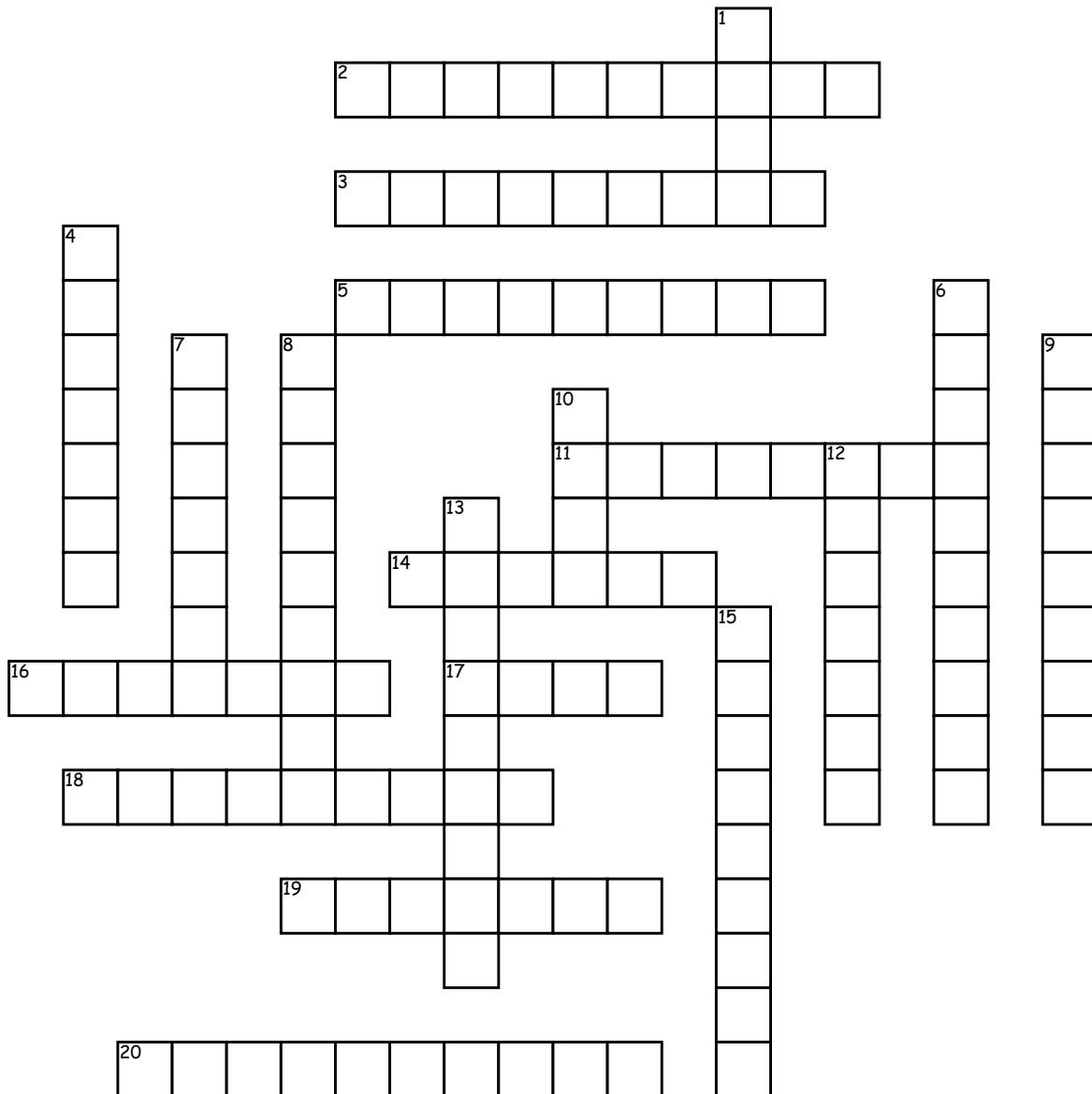


Unit 15 Crossword Puzzle
