

- **13.** Physical properties of the troposphere of an area based on analysis of its weather records
- **15.** Cloudiness in a volume of water: a measure of water clarity in lakes, streams, and other bodies of water
- **16.** Perennially frozen layer of soil that forms when the water there freezes
- **17.** Population is so low that it could soon become extinct
- 19. Destruction of vegetation when too many grazing animals feed on specific pasture for too long and exceed carrying capacity

- **5.** Area of shoreline between low and high tides
