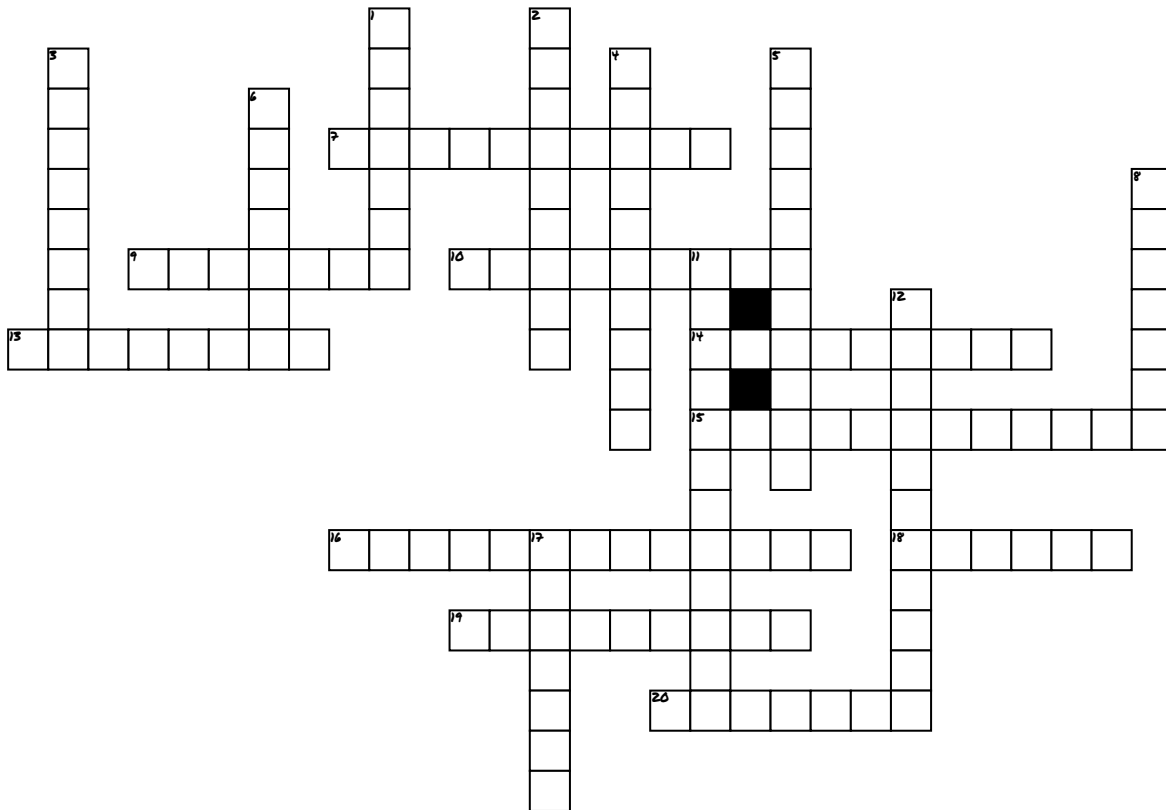

5. RESULTING FROM OR MARKED BY LACK OF ATTENTION; UNINTENTIONAL, ACCIDENTAL

6. A STATE OF GREAT EXCITEMENT, AGITATION, OR TURBULENCE; (V) TO BE IN OR WORK INTO SUCH WASTE; TO PRODUCE ALCOHOL BY CHEMICAL ACTION

8. EXISTING IN NAME ONLY, NOT REAL; TOO SMALL TO BE CONSIDERED OR TAKEN SERIOUSLY

11. RESULTING FROM CHANCE RATHER THAN FROM AN INHERENT CAUSE OR CHARACTER; ACCIDENTAL, NOT ESSENTIAL; (MEDICINE) ACQUIRED, NOT CONGENITAL

12. TO SYMPATHIZE WITH, HAVE PITY OR SORROW FOR, SHARE A FEELING OF DISTRESS
