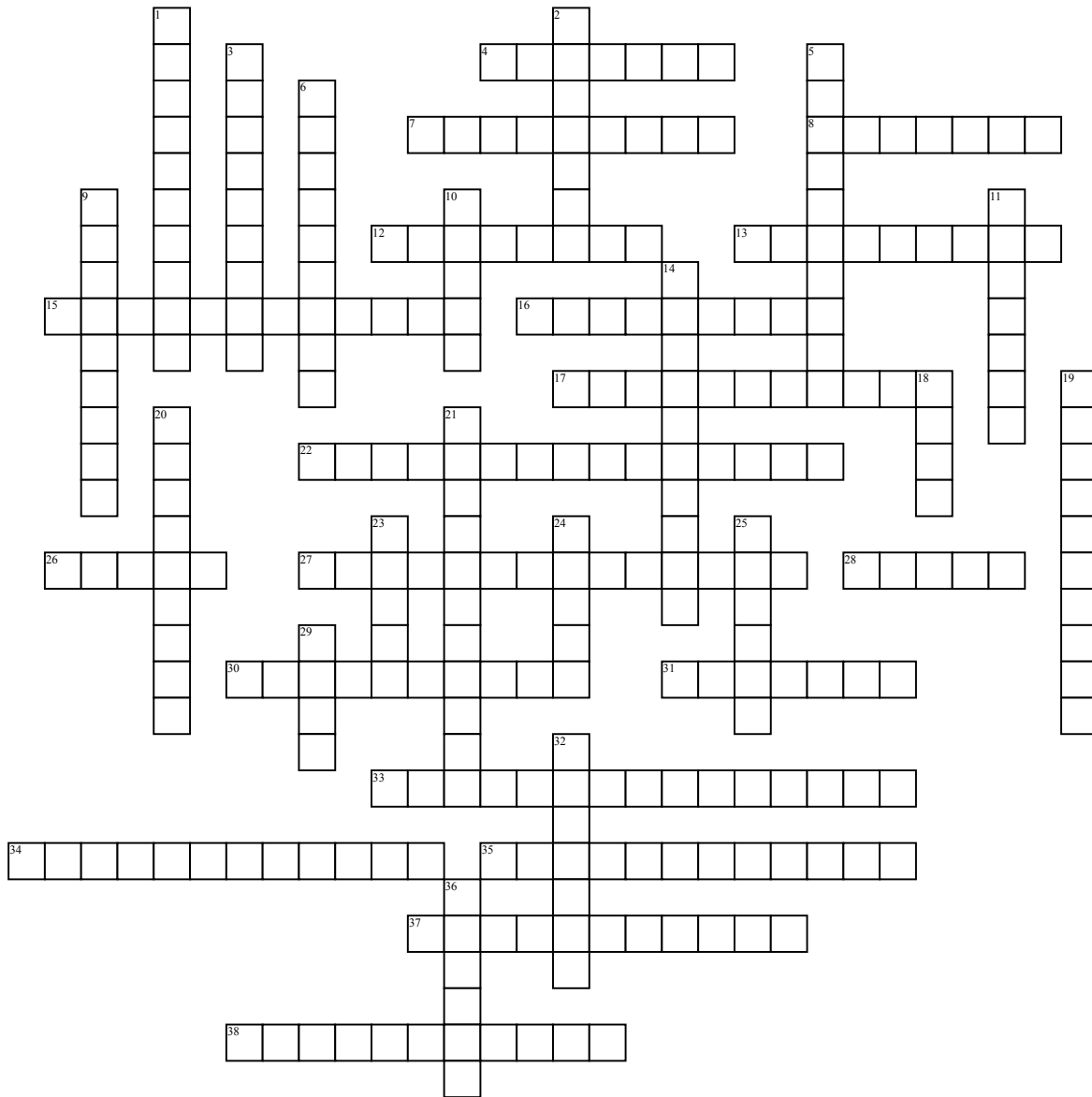


# Unit 4 Croossword Puzzle
