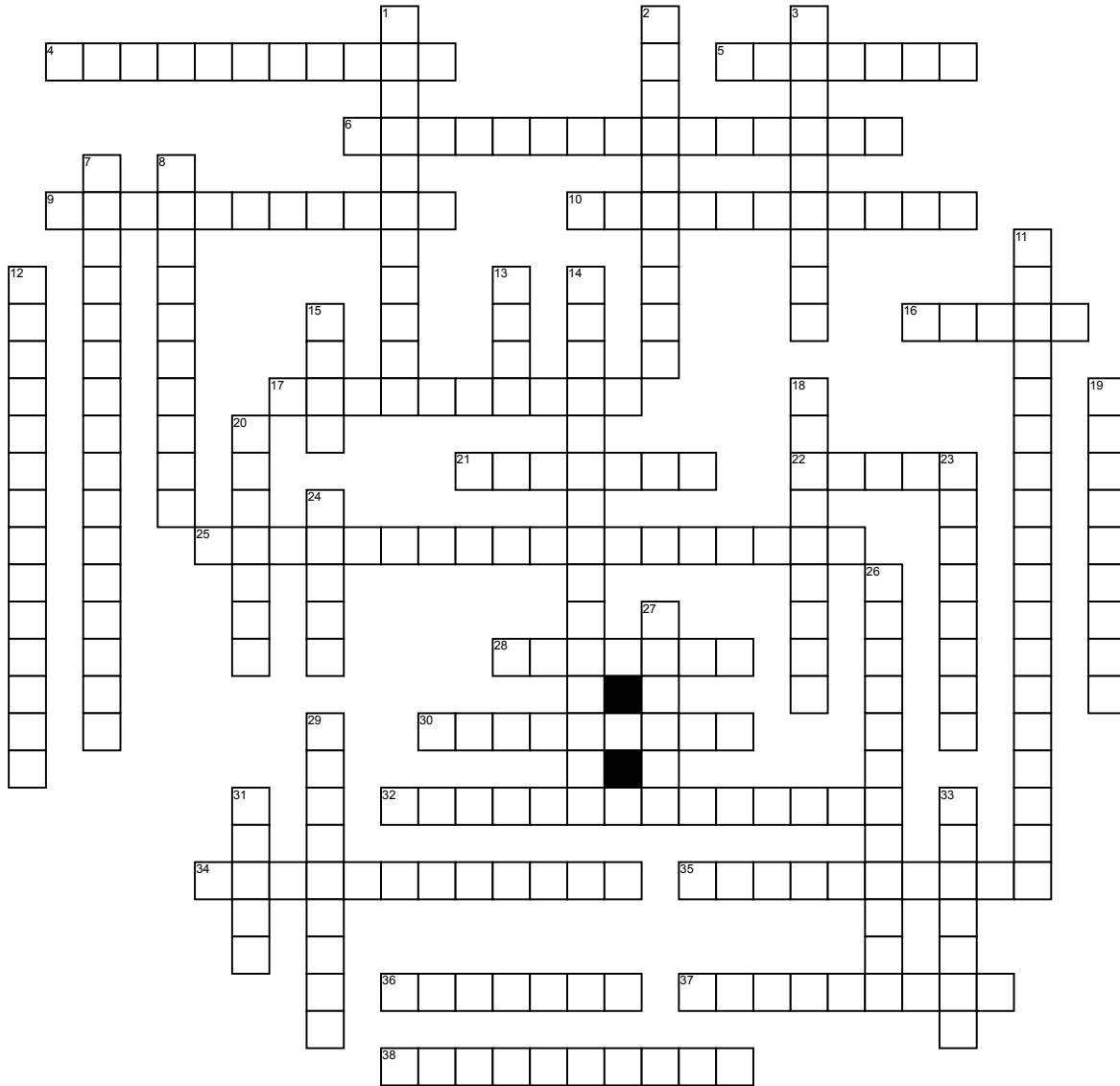

- 5. A large floating mass of ice detached from a glacier or ice sheet and carried out to sea.
- 6. The area surrounding the lower Yellow River and its Tributaries.
- 9. A group of islands.
- 10. Areas with annual precipitation less than 250 mm and a mean temperature during the warmest month of less than 10° C.
- 16. A triangular tract of sediment deposited at the mouth of a river, typically where it diverges into several outlets.
- 17. A person, animal, or plant that has been in a country or region from earliest times.
- 21. The second-longest river in Asia.
- 22. A member of the aboriginal people of New Zealand.
- 25. The continental portion of Southeast Asia lying east of India and south of China.

- 1. Is a trans-boundary river in Southeast Asia.
 - 2. A layer in the earth's stratosphere at an altitude of about 6.2 miles (10 km) containing a high concentration of ozone, which absorbs most of the ultraviolet radiation reaching the earth from the sun.
 - 3. One of the three principal divisions of Oceania, comprising the island groups in the S Pacific NE of Australia.
 - 7. The largest living thing on Earth, and even visible from outer space.
 - 8. The longest river in Asia and the third-longest in the world.
 - 11. The largest peninsula of Antarctica, between the Weddell Sea and the Pacific.
 - 12. The land mass runs approximately north-south and, at its terminus, is the southernmost point of the Asian mainland.
 - 13. A pilgrimage site for centuries, it's considered one of Japan's 3 sacred mountains.
 - 14. A peninsula in East Asia that is surrounded by the Sea of Japan.

- 15. A large desert region in Asia. It covers parts of northern and northwestern China, and of southern Mongolia.
- 18. The Himalayan range has the Earth's highest peaks, including the highest, Mount Everest.
- 19. A ridge of rock in the sea formed by the growth and deposit of coral.
- 20. Along high sea wave caused by an earthquake, submarine landslide, or other disturbance.
- 23. A floating sheet of ice permanently attached to a landmass.
- 24. A loosely compacted yellowish-gray deposit of windblown sediment of which extensive deposits occur.
- 26. A large, distinguishable part of a continent, such as North America or southern Africa.
- 27. A giant, rugged island in Southeast Asia's Malay Archipelago.
- 29. A subregion of Oceania, made up of over 1,000 islands scattered over the central and southern Pacific Ocean.
