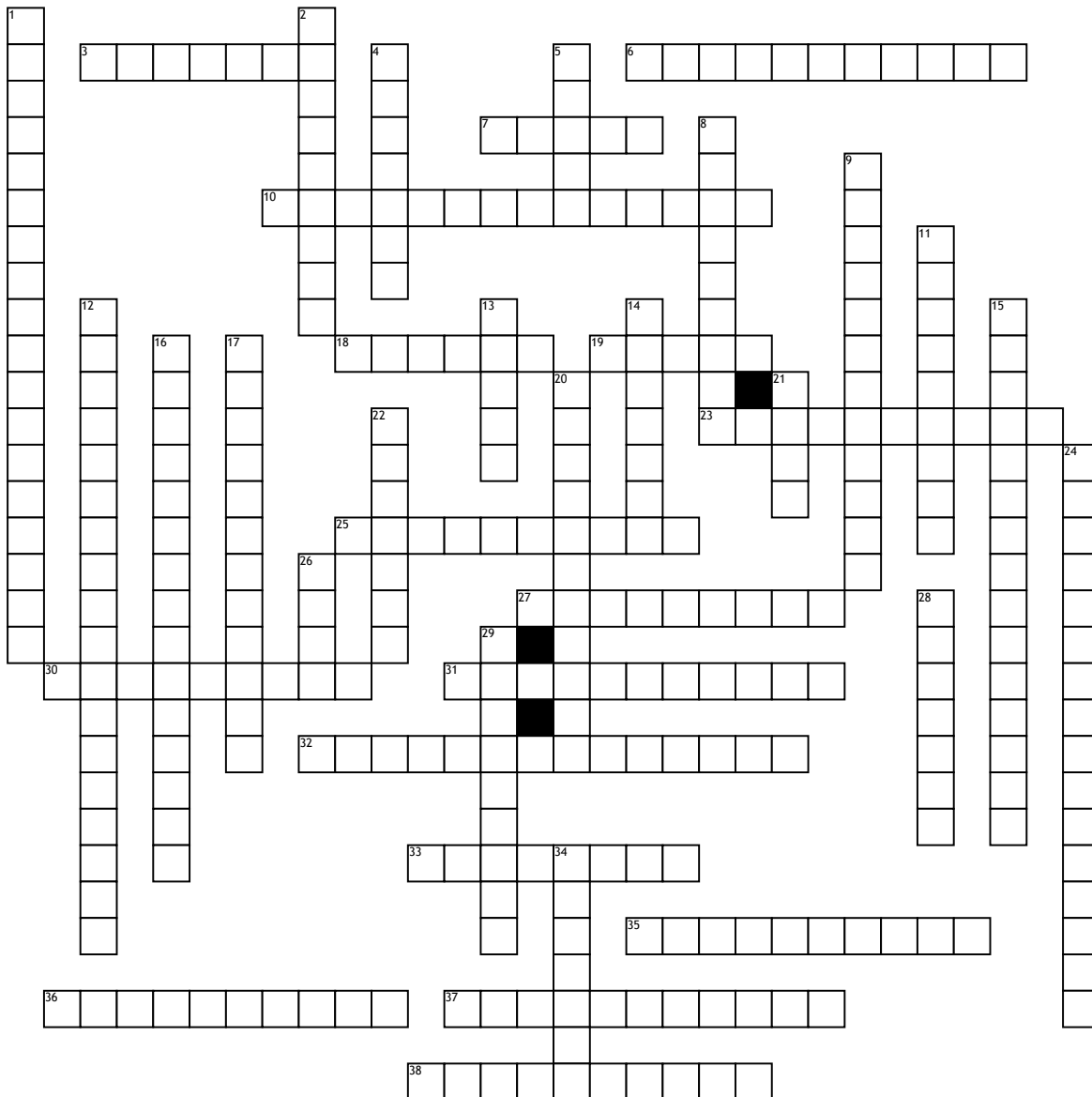


# Unit 4 Crossword Puzzle



## Across

3. an unusually large sea wave produced by a seaquake or undersea volcanic eruption.  
 6. a trans-boundary river in Southeast Asia  
 7. a ring-shaped coral reef including a coral rim that encircles a lagoon partially or completely  
 10. lying between the Andaman Sea of the Indian Ocean and the Strait of Malacca on the west and the Gulf of Thailand and the South China Sea on the east  
 18. the third-largest island in the world and the largest island in Asia.  
 19. a loamy deposit formed by wind, usually yellowish and calcareous  
 23. indigenous peoples of Taiwan  
 25. a river in E Asia, flowing from the Tibetan plateau through central China to the East China Sea. About 3200 miles (5150 km) long.  
 27. a term for types of administrative division, usually an area that is under the jurisdiction of a state  
 30. is a subregion of Oceania (and occasionally Australasia) extending from the western end of the Pacific Ocean to the Arafura Sea, and eastward to Fiji.  
 31. areas with annual precipitation less than 250 millimetres (9.8 in) and a mean temperature of less than 10 °C (50 °F) during the warmest months  
 32. Also called Tibetan Highlands, Roof of the World

33. a thick floating platform of ice that forms where a glacier or ice sheet flows down to a coastline and onto the ocean surface  
 35. a river also called Sindhū or Abāsīn, is a major south-flowing river in South Asia.  
 36. is a subregion of Oceania, comprising thousands of small islands in the western Pacific Ocean.  
 37. a river considered one of the most sacred places in Hinduism.  
 38. a region of Earth's stratosphere that absorbs most of the Sun's ultraviolet (UV) radiation

1. the northernmost part of the mainland of Antarctica, located at the base of the Southern Hemisphere  
 2. contain the world's highest mountains, including Mount Everest.  
 4. is the vast, remote, arid interior of Australia  
 5. the culture of the Māori people  
 8. is a subregion of Oceania, made up of over 1,000 islands scattered over the central and southern Pacific Ocean  
 9. a large, distinguishable part of a continent  
 11. a large island in the South West Pacific region.  
 12. a peninsula in SE Asia, between the Bay of Bengal and the South China Sea, comprising Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, W Malaysia, and Burma (Myanmar).

13. is a landform that forms from deposition of sediment carried by a river  
 14. a seasonal prevailing wind in the region of South and Southeast Asia  
 15. a peninsula in East Asia that extends southwards for about 684 miles or 1,100 kilometers from the continental Asia into the Pacific Ocean  
 16. is the area surrounding the lower Yellow River and its Tributaries  
 17. tallest mountain in Asia  
 20. sometimes called an island group or island chain, is a chain, cluster or collection of islands.  
 21. a desert in Eastern Asia, mostly in Mongolia  
 22. a place where fish or shellfish are caught  
 24. is the world's largest coral reef system  
 26. a dormant volcano in central Japan, on Honshu island: highest mountain in Japan  
 28. a large piece of freshwater ice that has broken off a glacier or an ice shelf and is floating freely in open water  
 29. are diverse underwater ecosystems held together by calcium carbonate structures secreted by corals  
 34. the second largest river in Asia
