

 15. German troops that King George III hired when he proclaimed the colonies to be in rebellion on August 1775, angered colonists

1. A British general who submitted a plan for invading New York State from Canada. He attempted to advance troops from Canada to the Albany area but was forced to surrender at Saratoga (1777).
 2. This freed slaves and forced slave owners to let them fight during the revolution.
 3. Pennsylvanian who accompanied her husband when he joined the Continental Army. After he died in battle, she took his place
 4. Patriot who disguised herself as a man and served in the Continental Army.

5. Prussian soldier who helped train American forces at Valley Forge in the American Revolutionary War.

6. The commander of a powerful French army of 6,000 troops who landed in Newport, RI in the summer of 1780 and helped plan for a potential Franco-American attack on New York.
 8. a hit-and-run technique used in fighting a war; fighting by small bands of warriors using tactics such as sudden ambushes
 9. 1776 wrote Common Sense
 10. A member of the House of Burgesses who wrote the Declaration of Independence
 12. a person in the American colonies who wanted the colonies to become independent from Great Britain
