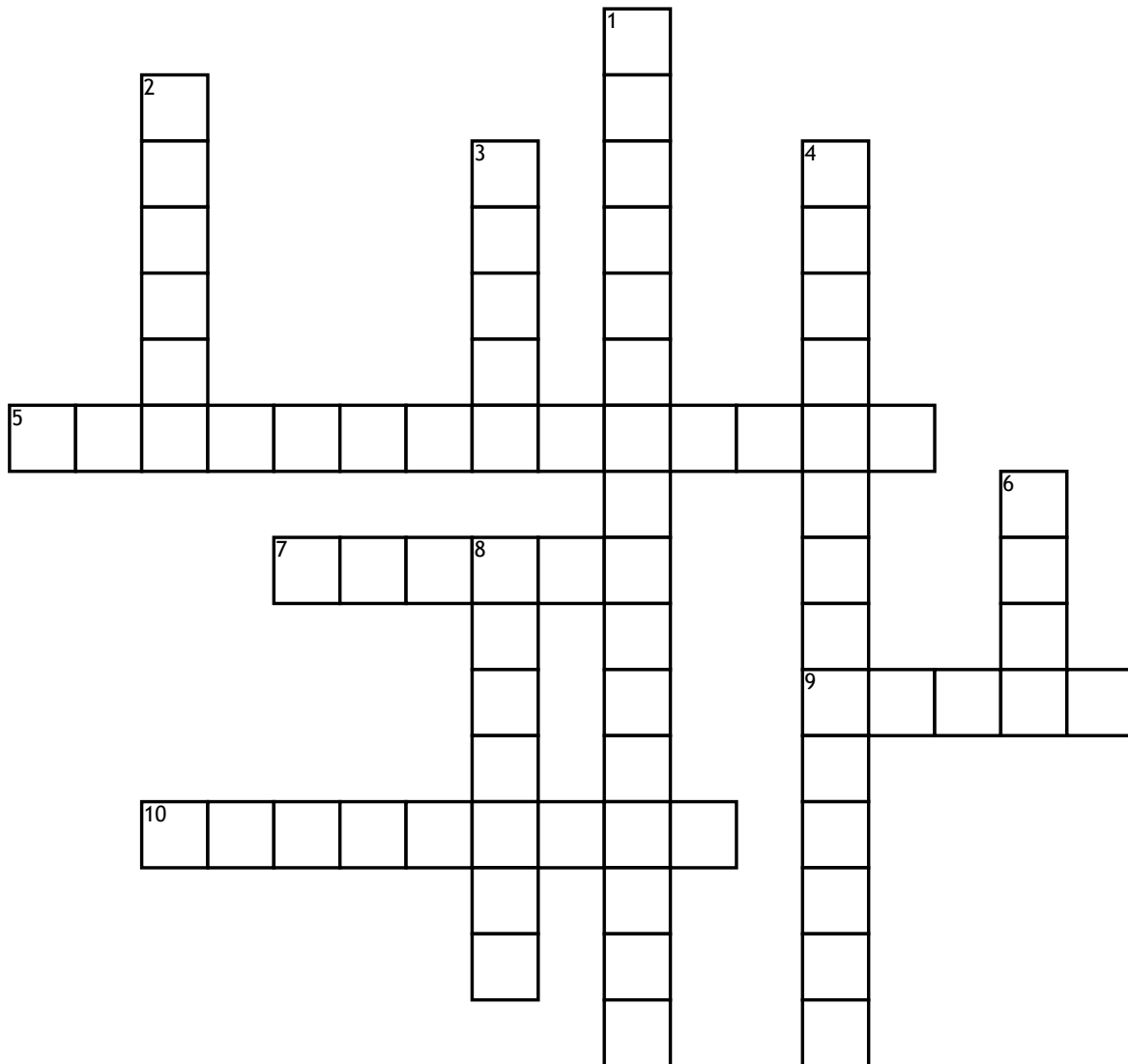

- 1. a system of land cultivation under which the common land is divided into three parts of which one or two in rotation lie fallow in each year and the rest are cultivated.

- 2. the body of all people ordained for religious duties, especially in the Christian Church.
- 3. someone or something having power, authority, or influence; a master or ruler
- 4. was an economic and social system of medieval Europe. All legal and economic power belonged to the lord of the manor, who was supported economically from his land and from contributions from the peasant population under his authority
- 6. an estate of land, especially one held on condition of feudal service.
- 8. denoting attitudes, activities, or other things that have no religious or spiritual basis.
