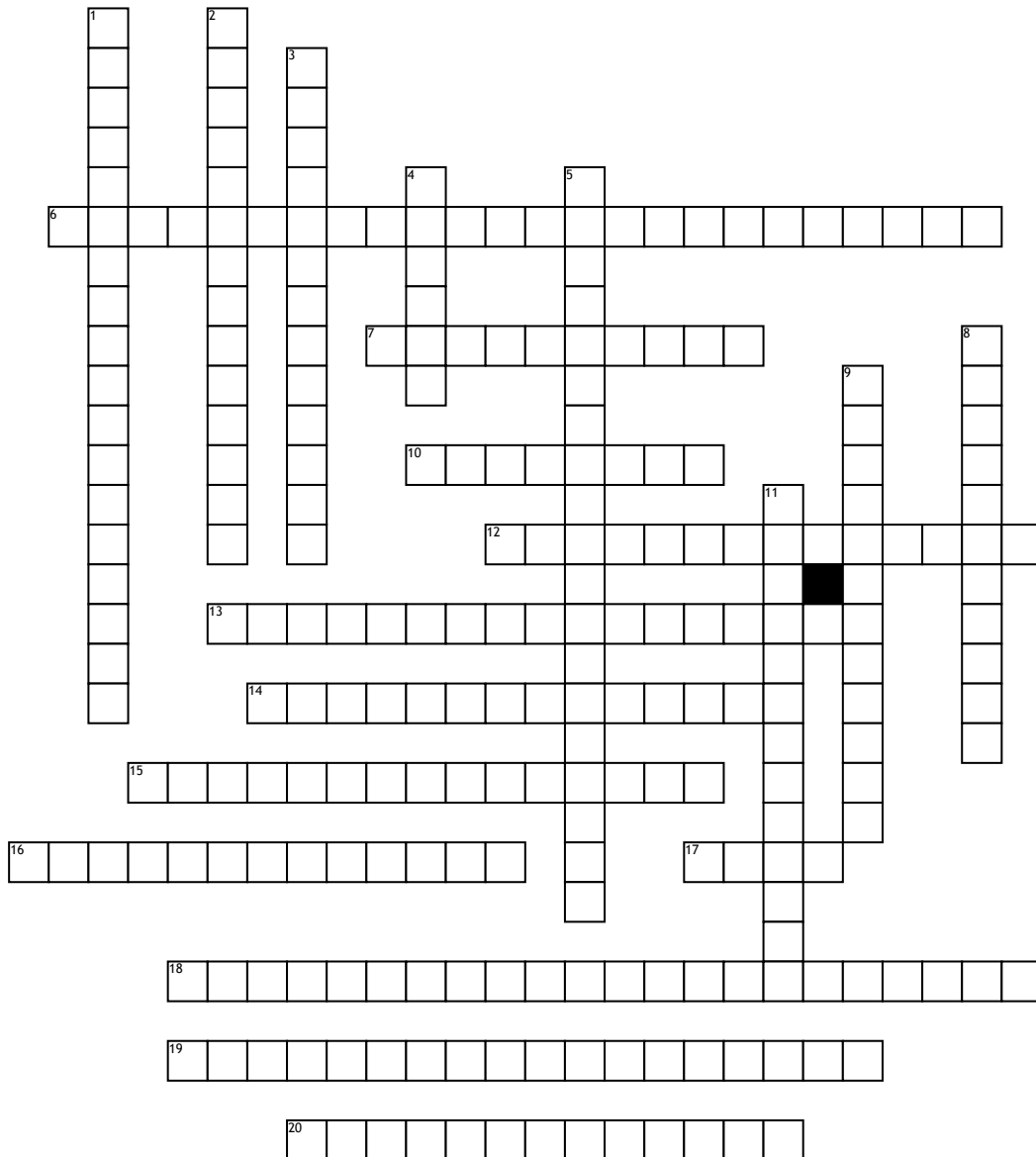


Unit 5: Political Parties (Pt 2)

6. an organization that raises money privately to influence elections
 7. propose/formally enter as a candidate for election
 10. containing one polling place, in a city, and is divided for voting purposes
 12. voters may pick one candidate for each office without regard to party lines
 13. when a voter in an election votes for candidates from different political parties
 14. tendency for a popular political party leader to attract votes for other candidates of the same party in an election
 15. a regular election of candidates for office

16. a second primary between the two leading candidates of the first primary to provide nomination by majority rather than by plurality
 17. administrative division of a city or borough that typically elects and is represented by councilor(s)
 18. parties rooted in poor economic times, lacking clear strategy, dissatisfied with current condition
 19. a political party that campaigns on only one issue
 20. type of primary election where a voter must affiliate formally with a political party in advance of the election date

1. political organizations committed to a comprehensive set of beliefs or a social/political ideology

2. a vote cast by someone who is unable or unwilling to attend the official polling station
 3. election where a party's candidates for public office are nominated by direct vote of the people
 4. a process of voting, in writing and typically in secret
 5. each candidate for office is eligible based on her or his own merits rather than as a member of a political party
 8. election where voters are not required to declare party affiliation
 9. where voters cast their ballots in elections
 11. a small organization that has broken away from a larger one
