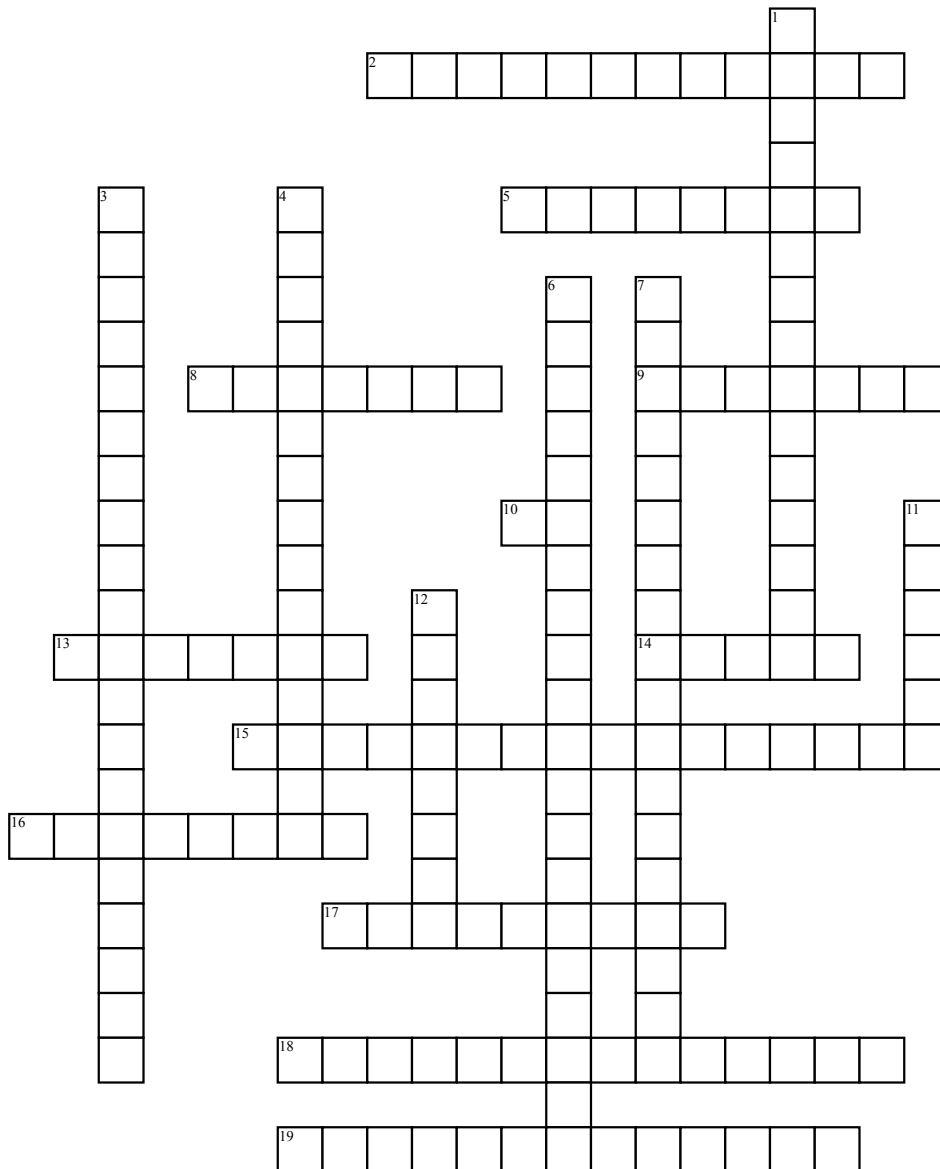


Unit 7 & 8 Government Crossword
