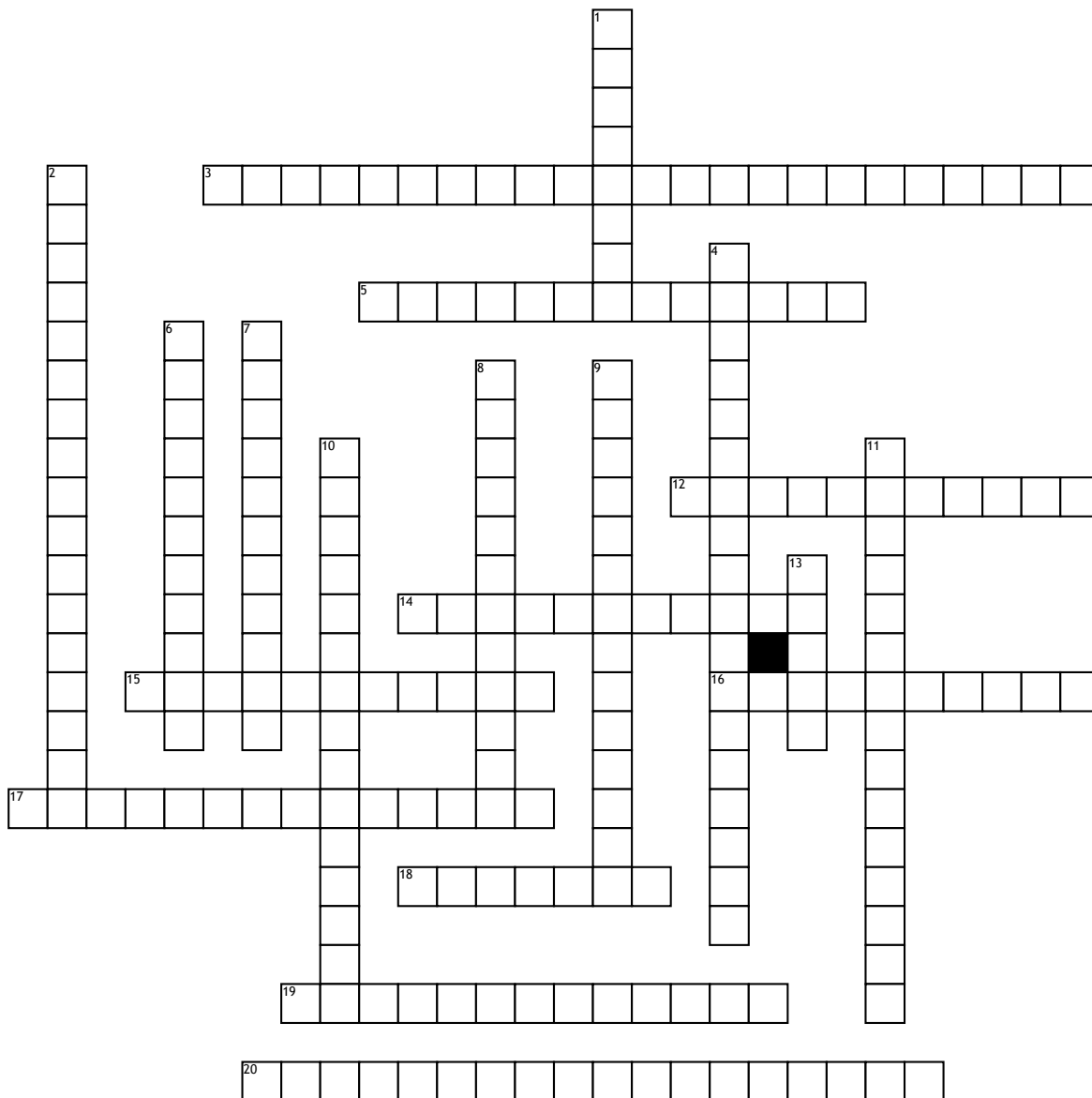

12. Men hired by eastern companies to trap animals for fur in the Rocky Mountains and other western regions of the United States

14. A 2,000-mile trail stretching through the Great Plains from western Missouri to the Oregon Territory

15. A gold-seeker who moved to California during the gold rush

16. 11th president of the United States and supported of Jacksonian Democracy

17. A revolt against Mexico by American settlers in California who declared the territory an independent republic (1846)

18. members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints

19. Two explorers who went on an expedition in 1804 to explore the Louisiana Purchase

20. was an armed conflict between the United States of America and Mexico from 1846 to 1848.

7. A group of western travelers who were stranded in the Sierra Nevada during the winter of 1846-47; only 45 of the party's 87 members survived

8. An important trade trail west from Independence, Missouri, to Santa Fe, New Mexico

9. The founder of Texas

10. U.S. purchase of land from Mexico that included the southern parts of present-day Arizona and New Mexico (1853)

11. A belief shared by many Americans in the mid-1800s that the United States should expand across the continent to the Pacific Ocean
