

Upper Extremity



<u>Across</u>

- **2.** Rounded knob on the humerous that articulates with the radius
- 4. Bone forming the elbow
- **5.** Shoulder bone that has no attatchment to the axial skeleton
- **8.** Medial bone of the forearm in anatomical position
- **9.** Shoulder bone that articulates anteriorlybwith the sternum
- **12.** The heads of these bones form the knuckles
- **13.** Lateral bone of the forearm in anatomical position
- **14.** Depression in the scapula for the arm bone
- **15.** Process above the glenoid cavity that permits muscle attatchemnt

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Raised area on the lateral surface of humerous to which the deltoid muscle attaches
- **3.** Bones of the fingers
- **6.** Distal medial process of the humerous; joins the ulna
- 7. Arm bone
- **10.** Point where the scapula and clavicle connect
- 11. Bone of the wrists
