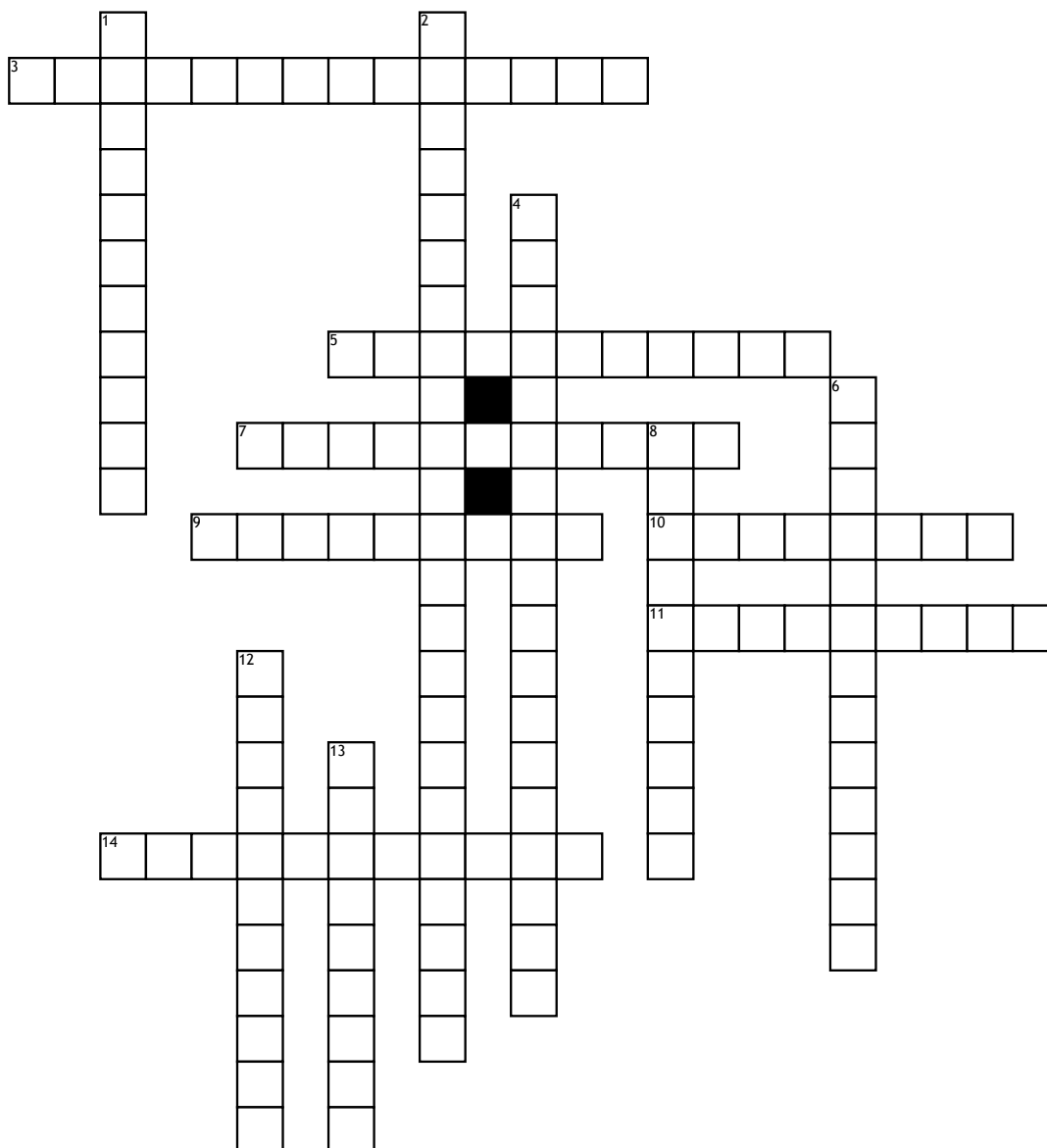

3. inflammation of the substance of the kidney as a result of bacterial infection.

5. the presence of albumin in the urine, typically as a symptom of kidney disease.

1. The surgical crushing of a nerve.

2. condition where the cartilage that keeps the airway (trachea) open is soft such that the trachea partly collapses especially during increased airflow
