

**8.** Urine specimen that does not include the first and last urine voided

**9.** Condition in which kidneys have failed and dialysis or transplantation is required to sustain life

10. Chemical substances that the body produces when it does not have enough insulin in the blood
11. Infection that occurs in the urethra, bladder, ureter, or kidney when bacteria travels up a catheter
