


Urinary System Vocabulary Grade 6

2. A group of organs which filter the blood and remove wastes from the body.
4. Tube that carries urine from the kidneys down to the bladder.
6. The part of the kidney that produces urine as it filters the blood.
7. Liquid waste created by the kidneys; contains water, salts and electrolytes (a type of salt), and chemicals like urea and uric acid.
8. Waste product of your liver breaking down proteins into amino acids; filtered from the blood by the kidneys.

9. Tube that allows the urine to travel from the urinary bladder to the outside of the body.

10. Small, bean-shaped organs that filter the blood, remove waste, and control the balance of fluids in the body.

1. A hormone created in the hypothalamus and released by the pituitary gland; ADH signals the kidneys to use less water when creating urine.
3. A hollow organ lined with muscle that stores urine collected from the kidneys.
5. The act of releasing urine from the body.
