

- 2. A group of organs which filter the blood and remove wastes from the body.
- **4.** Tube that carries urine from the kidneys down to the bladder.
- **6.** The part of the kidney that produces urine as it filters the blood.
- 7. Liquid waste created by the kidneys; contains water, salts and electrolytes (a type of signals the kidneys to use less water when salt), and chemicals like urea and uric acid.
- 8. Waste product of your liver breaking down proteins into amino acids; filtered from the blood by the kidneys.

- 9. Tube that allows the urine to travel from the urinary bladder to the outside of the body.
- 10. Small, bean-shaped organs that filter the blood, remove waste, and control the balance of fluids in the body.

- 1. A hormone created in the hypothalamus and released by the pituitary gland; ADH creating urine.
- **3.** A hollow organ lined with muscle that stores urine collected from the kidneys.
- 5. The act of releasing urine from the body.
