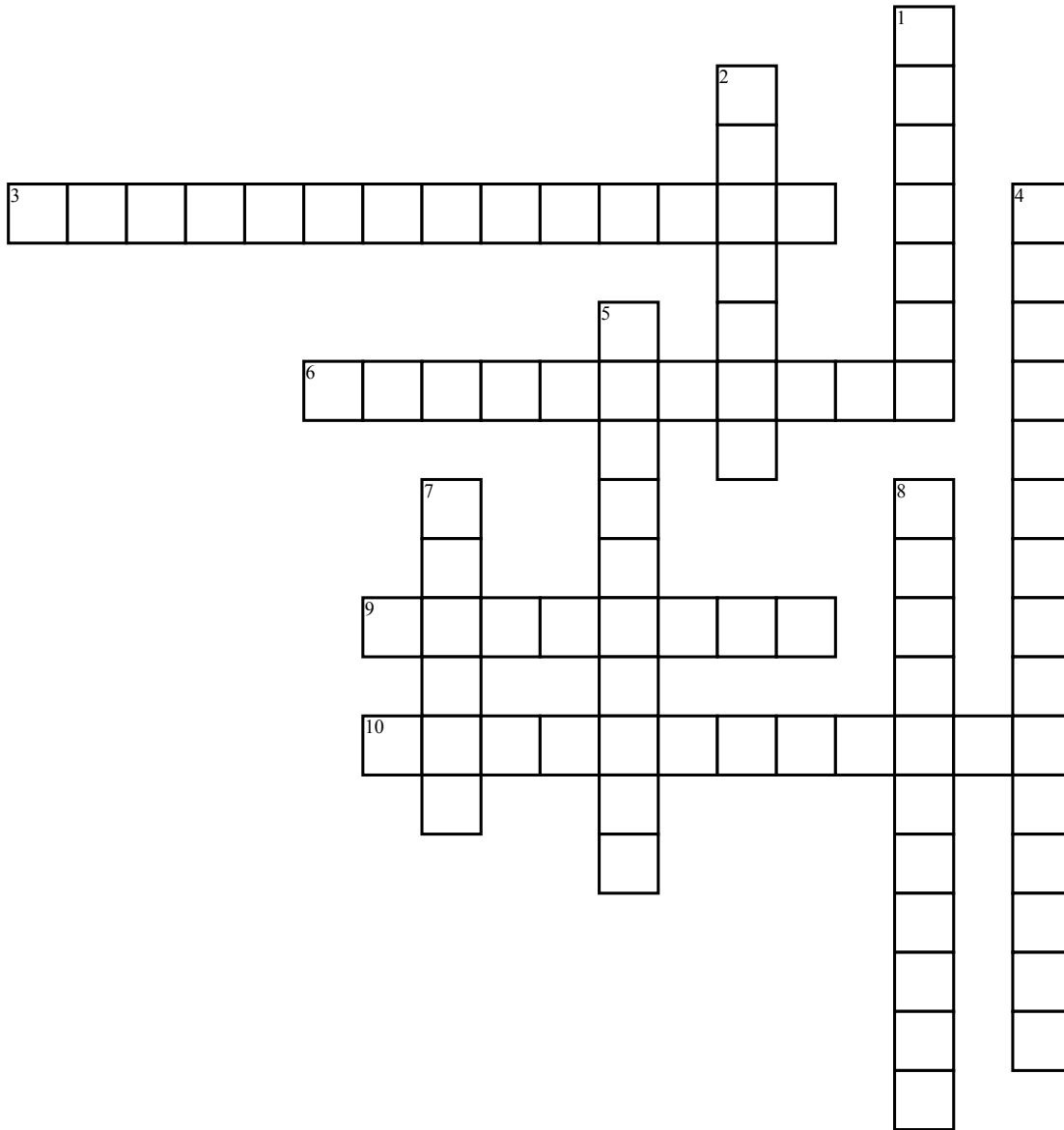


# Urinary Systems

- 1. Bean shaped organ in the renal system. helps the body pass waste as urine

- 2. A tube that connects the urinary bladder to the urinary meatus for the removal of urine.
- 4. a cup like sack at the beginning of the tubular component of a nephron in the mammalian kidney
- 5. a cluster of nerve endings or small blood vessels in particular a cluster of capillaries around the end of a kidney tubule where waste products are filtered from the blood
- 7. a duct by which urine passes from the kidney to the bladder or cloaca
- 8. outer portion of the kidney
