

- **5.** Long tube-like extensions in horses that carry urine to the renal pelvis
- **6.** Type of epithelium found in the bladder

- **7.** The paired functional organ of the urinary system
- **9.** The branch of the abdominal aorta that delivers blood to the kidney
- **12.** Part of the female reproductive and urinary tracts that extends from the urethral opening to the outer genitalia
- **14.** The areas in the kidney where the renal vein, artery, and ureter connects
- **16.** Layer of the kidney deep to the capsule. Contains renal corpuscles and convoluted parts of renal tubules
- **19.** This species has kidneys at equal levels and no renal crest
