

- **4.** Vertebral column bone that helps form pelvic girdle; 5 fused bones
- **5.** Process projecting posteriorly from vertebrae

- **7.** Cartilage pads between main parts of successive vertebrae
- **8.** Type of rib that is not directly connected to the sternum; connected to rib above
- **9.** Process on vertebrae with which the tubercle of the rib articulates
- **10.** Type of rib with no anterior articulation
- 12. Breastbone
- 17. Tail Bone
