

- **8.** Set of reactions in photosynthesis that do not require light. Also called the Calvin Cycle
- **9.** Process that releases energy by breaking down glucose and other food molecules in the presence of oxygen
- 10. Light-absorbing molecule used by plants to gether the sun's energy
- 11. Process used by plants and other autotrophs to capture light energy and jse it to power chemical reactions that convert carbon dioxide and water into oxygen and energy-rich carbohydrates such as sugars and starches
- **12.** Set of reactions in photosynthesis that use energy from light to produce ATP and NADPH
- 13. Second stage of cellular respiration in which pyruvic acid is broken down into carbon dioxide in a series of energy-extracting reactions
