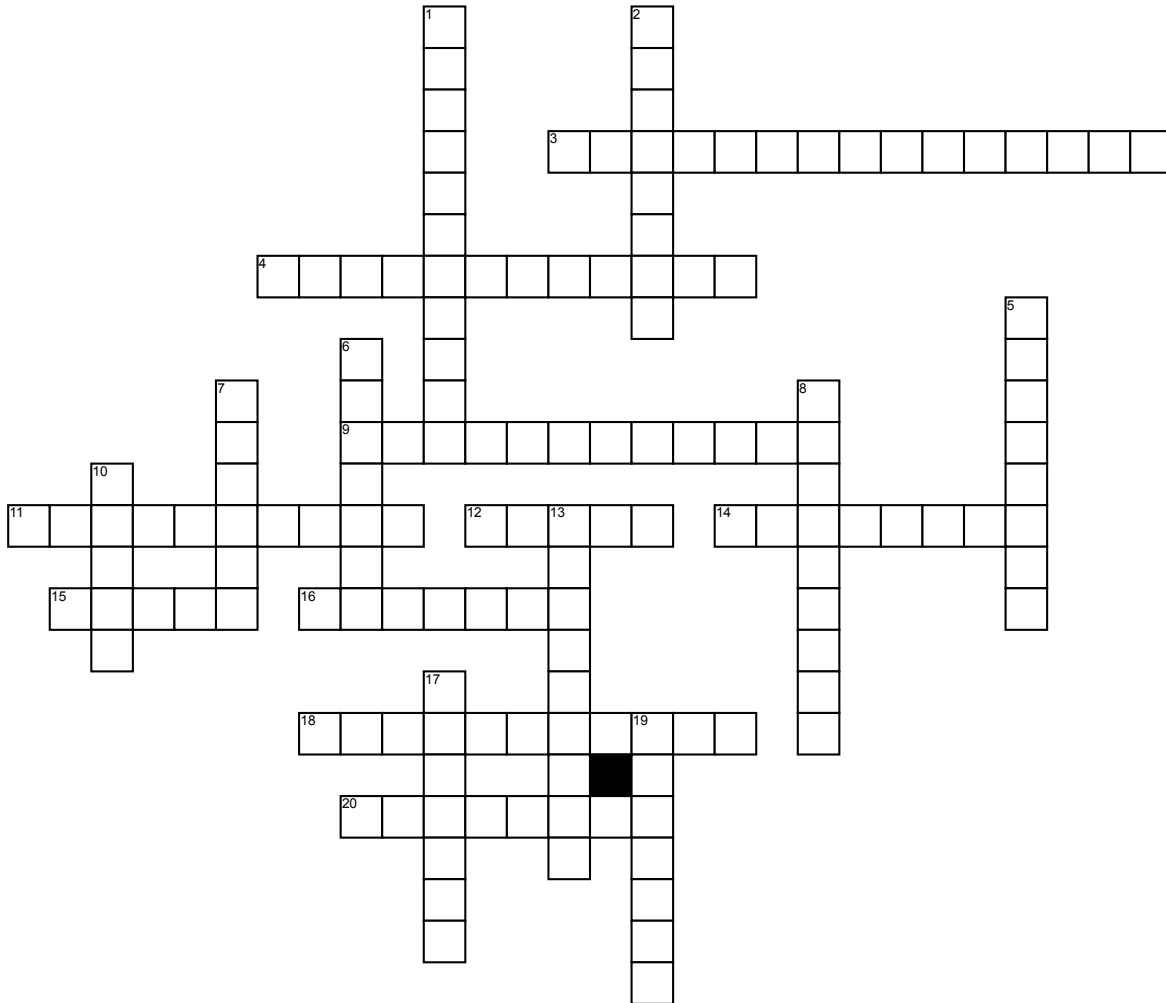


Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
