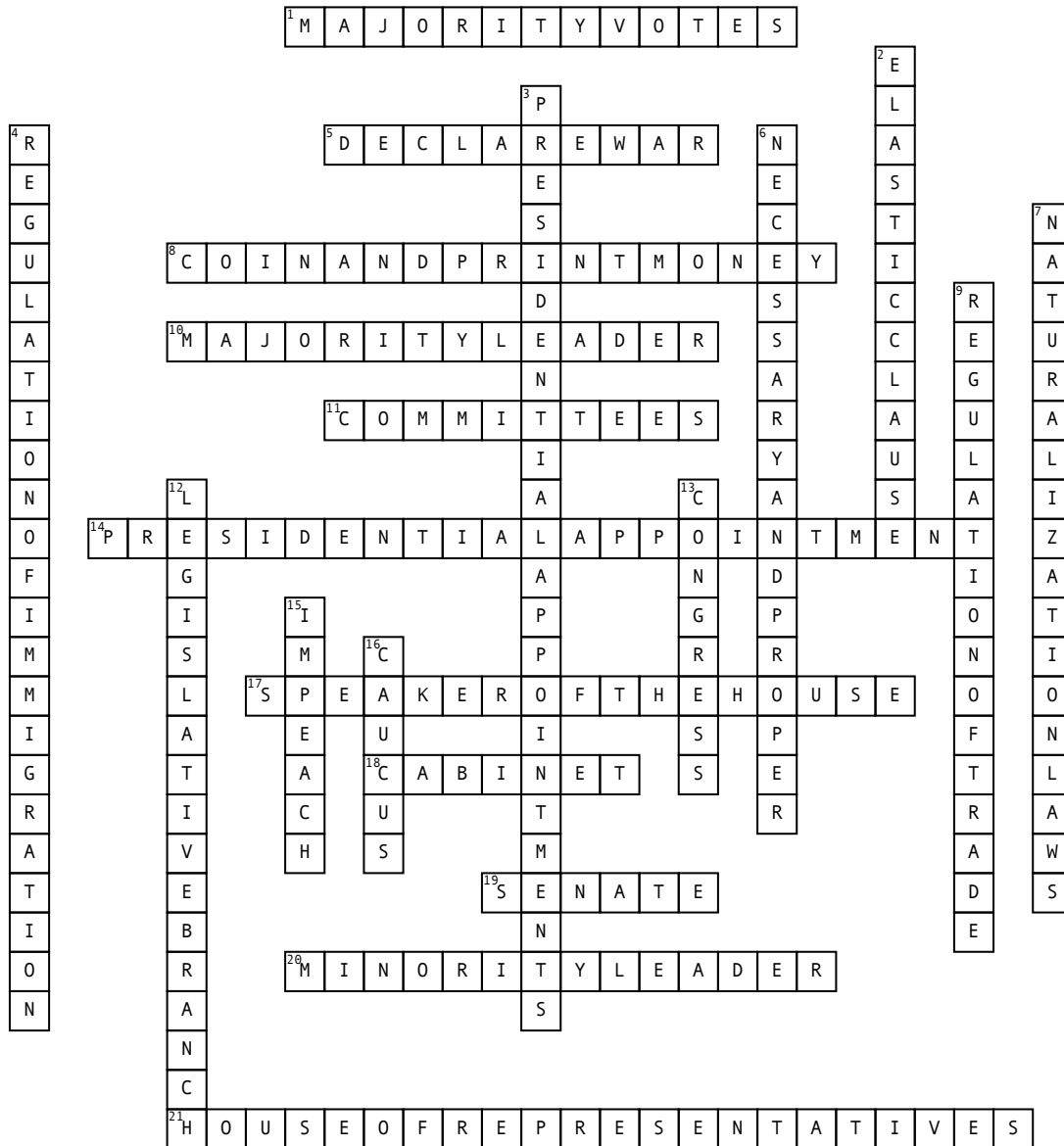

- 2. Clause that allows congress to extend its delegated powers.

 - 6. A section of the United States Constitution that enables Congress to make the laws required for the exercise of its other powers established by Constitution.

- 12. Deliberative assembly with the authority to make laws for a political entity such as a country or city.

- 16. A meeting at which local members of a political party register their preference among candidates running for office or select delegates to attend a convention.
