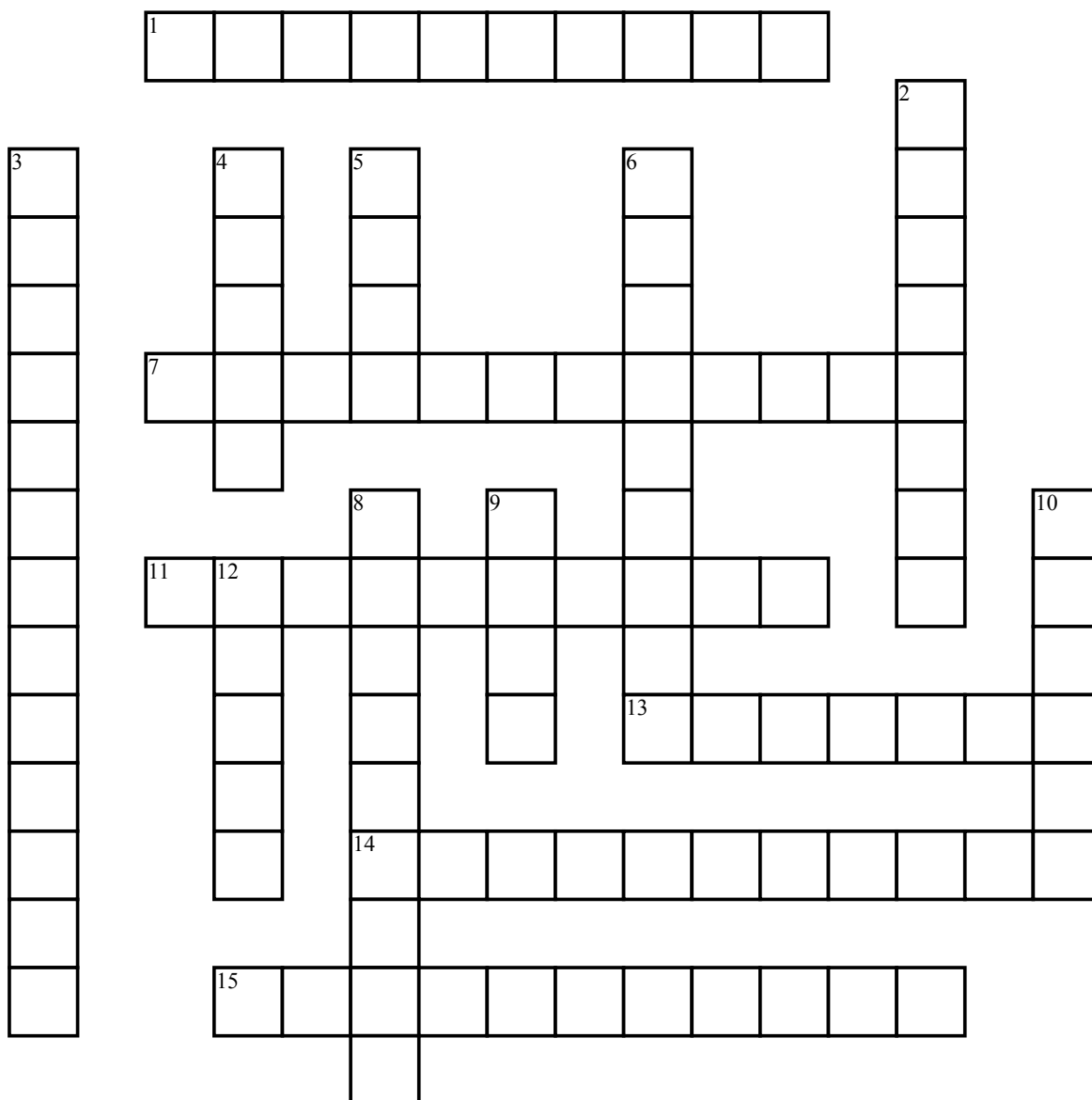

 13. characterized by defiance; boldly resistant or challenging
 14. the war between the Axis and the Allies, beginning on September 1, 1939, with the German invasion of Poland and ending with the surrender of Germany on May 8, 1945, and of Japan on August 14, 1945

2. keenly distressing to the feelings
 3. equipment, apparatus, or furnishings used in or necessary for a particular activity
 4. having or showing a dutiful spirit of reverence for God or an earnest wish to fulfill religious obligations
 5. a member of the National Socialist German Workers' Party, which controlled Germany from 1933 to 1945 under Adolf Hitler and advocated totalitarian government, territorial expansion, anti-Semitism, and Aryan supremacy, all these leading directly to World War II and the Holocaust

6. to make abnormally lean or thin by a gradual wasting away of flesh

8. a town in SW Poland: site of Nazi concentration camp during World War II
 9. a Nazi concentration camp prisoner who was given privileges in return for supervising prisoner work gangs: often a common criminal and frequently brutal to fellow inmates
 10. a section of a city, especially a thickly populated slum area, inhabited predominantly by members of an ethnic or other minority group, often as a result of social or economic restrictions, pressures, or hardships
 12. a decree issued by a sovereign or other authority
