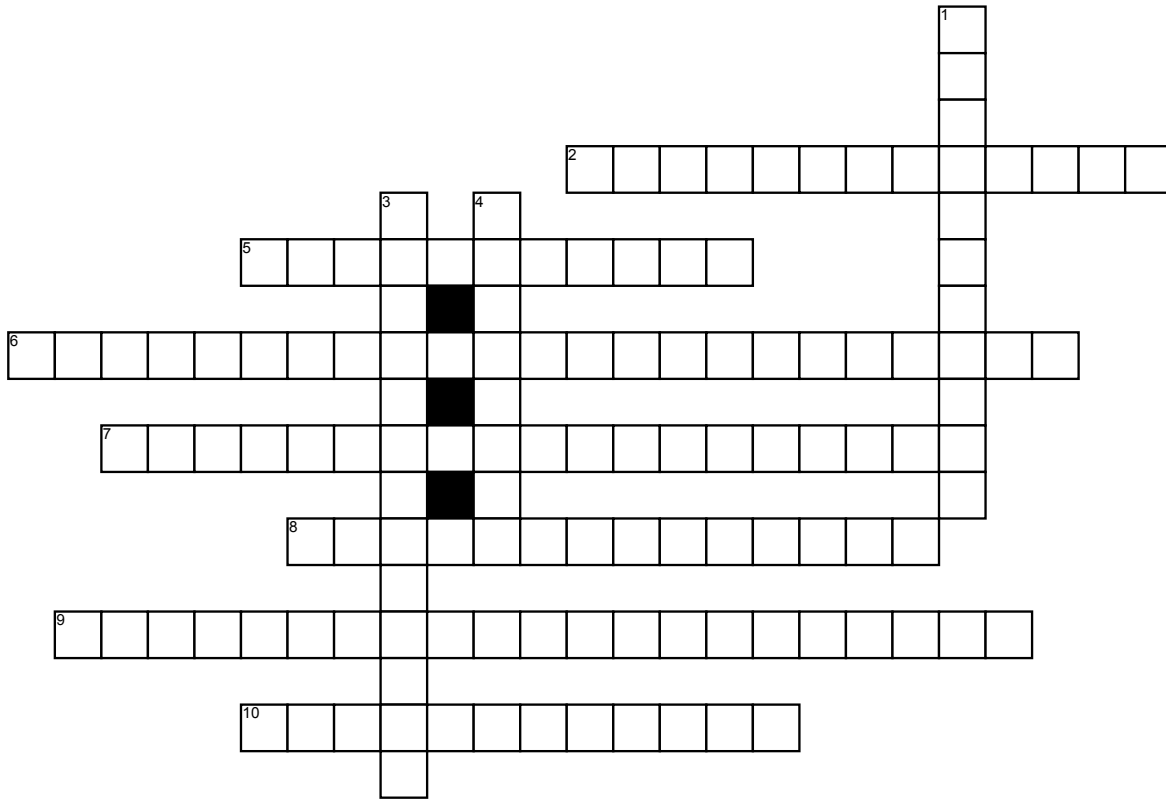

6. Uses a range of clues to read a text. (ex: Pat, Park, Pen, Page)
7. The recognition that written letters represent sounds of spoken language.
8. Students who are beginning to learn sound/symbol relationships--starting with consonants & short vowel & are able to read CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words, as well as a number of high-frequency words.

9. Words are removed from a reading passage learning blanks for students to fill in the blanks. (Must use a familiar passage)

10. The ability to quickly & accurately identify words. (ex: site words)
