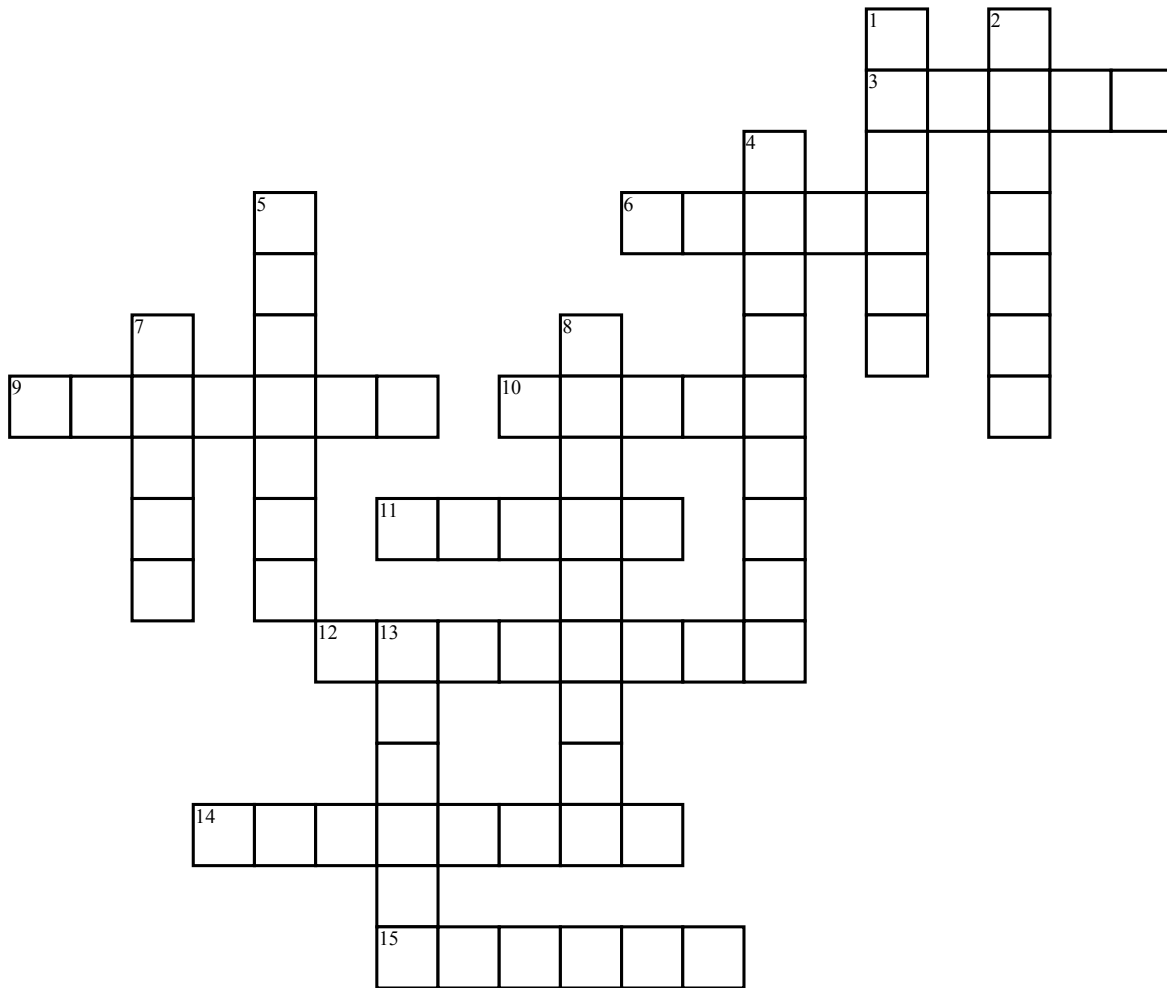


Vocabulary Words Crossword Puzzle
