

## **Across**

- **3.** A gradual change of one shade from dark to light.
- **6.** A piece of fabric worn over the shoe, extending to the ankle or the knee.
- 8. A jappanese sandal.
- **9.** The result of fabric being stretched as it is sewn, resulting in a wavy hemline.
- **11.** Ornamental work of fine wire, usually in silver or gold, with the addition of tiny beads.
- 13. A sharp, narrow fold.
- **16.** A white or off-white background on which a repeated pattern, depicting a detailed scene, appears.
- **18.** Small socks with evenly-spaced designs.
- **19.** A loose, pleated waistline that gives the impression of a scrunched bag when gathered at the waist.

- **20.** Sheer fabrics with a translucent effect.
- **23.** A small, close fitting and upright collar.
- **24.** An artistic technique where realistic imagery is used so to appear 3D.
- **25.** A decorative design made of one piece of fabric sewn on top of another.
- **26.** The section of a shoe that covers the heel.

## **Down**

- 1. The property of a fabric that appears to change colour as it catches the light.
- **2.** A V-shaped weave resembling the skeleton of a herringfish
- **4.** A skin-tight garment that covers the body from the neck to the wrists and ankles.
- **5.** A full, wide skirt with a tight, fitted waistline.

- **7.** A pocket set into the garment with a slit entrance, as opposed to a patch or flap pocket.
- **10.** A sleeve that sits in between sleeveless and short.
- **12.** Square in shape with minimal tailoring.
- **14.** The part of the garment around the neckline on the front and the back.
- **15.** A split in a garment to allow for movement.
- **17.** The style of a sleeve, where a continuous piece of fabric continues to the neck with no shoulder seam.
- 21. A thin, puckered, cotton fabric.
- 22. A decorative shoulder adornment.
