
## Volcanoes

**2.** Steep conical hill of loose pyroclastic fragments, such as either volcanic clinkers, cinders, volcanic ash built around a volcanic vent

**3.** Body of intrusive igneous rock.

**5.** Boundaries mark the collision between two of the planet's tecton

**6.** large, bowl-shaped cavity in the ground or on the surface of a planet or the moon, typically one caused by an explosion

**8.** A broad, domed volcano with gently sloping sides, characteristic of the eruption of fluid, basaltic lava.
