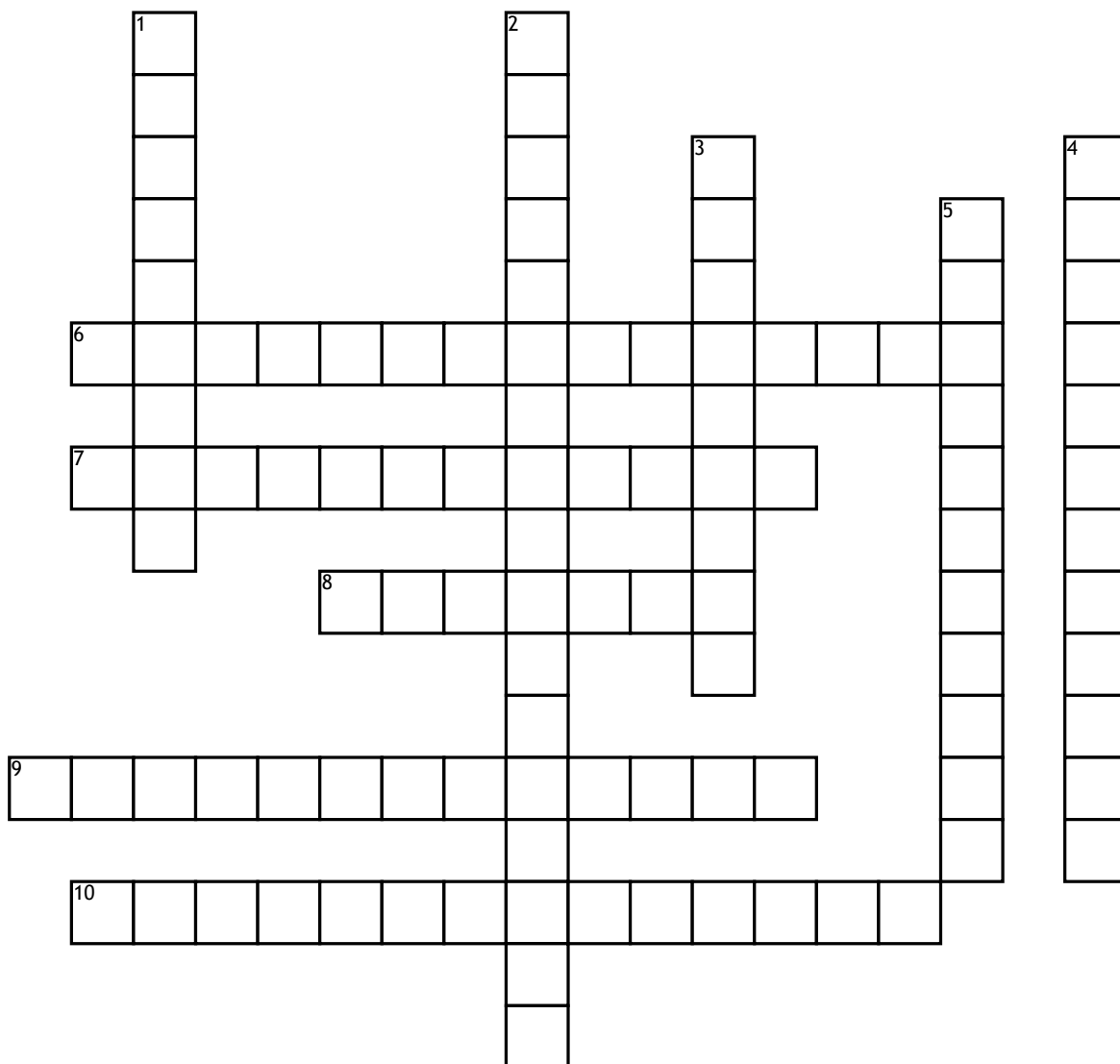


Voting Terms
