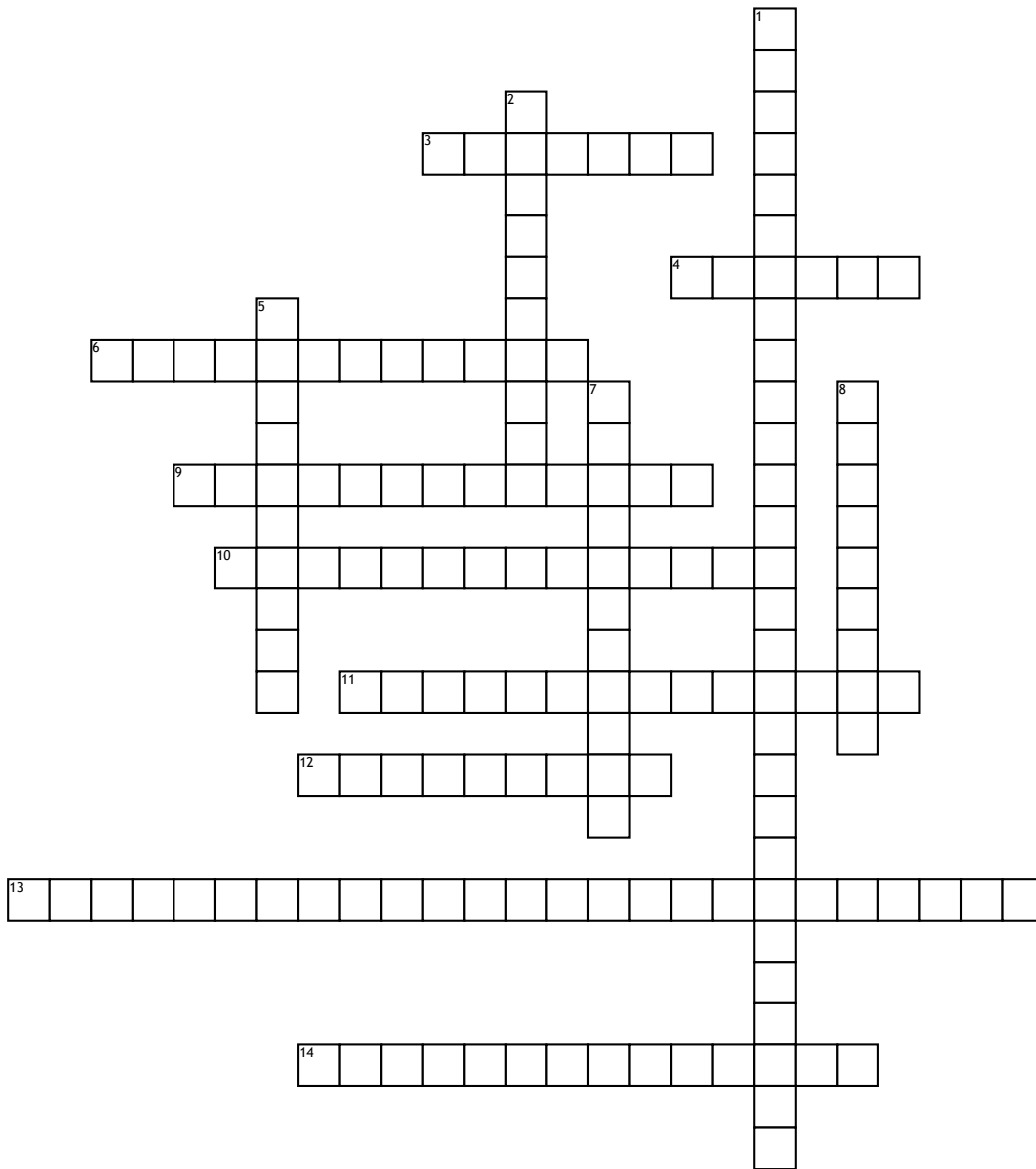


WATERSHED VOCABULARY

- 3. a layer of permeable rock that retains and filters water
- 4. the draining away of water from the surface of an area of land a building or structure
- 6. water from precipitation that drains in lakes and rivers
- 9. allows water to flow through the material the opposite of impermeable
- 10. below the water table

- 11. the upper portion of soil and rock that can be temporarily filled with water as the water enters the ground
- 12. An area of land where the surface water and the ground water drains.
- 13. a single identifiable and localized source of water pollution
- 14. a geographical barrier such as a hill or mountain separating one watershed from another

- 1. pollutants introduced into surface or groundwater that are without a specific location source
- 2. sunken land surface due to underlying compression of earth material as a result of the removal of groundwater
- 5. the top of the saturation zone
- 7. water that collects in cracks and pores in underground soil
